SPORTSMANSHIP RULES—CAMPOLINDO HIGH SCHOOL

Attendance at sporting events is not a right, but a privilege. Administrators, staff and teachers have the right to remove any individual for not adhering to these school rules/policies. The following behavior is unacceptable at <u>all</u> Campolindo sporting events:

- 1. Berating, yelling, booing or chanting at opposing players, coaches, schools or mascots before, during or after the game. Personal attacks will not be tolerated, including yells such as "Air Ball," "You, You, You," "Push it" or any other terms that sound like and/or rhyme with swear words.
- 2. Obscene or demeaning actions, cheers or gestures, including but not limited to turning backward during introductions, holding up newspapers, etc.
- 3. Negative signs or objects, including brooms, newspapers, etc., used to demean an opponent. All signs must show only positive support. Those which direct negative comments toward opponents or are unsportsmanlike or vulgar are not permitted.
- 4. Noisemakers: artificial noisemakers shall not be used at any event. Artificial noisemakers are items such as, but not limited to, megaphones, air horns, bells, whistles, clickers, thunder sticks, explosive devices, tape/CD players, jars with pennies, drums, large water bottles, conch shells, plastic horns and radios.
- 5. Laser pointers
- 6. Complaining about officials' calls (verbal or gestures)
- 7. Throwing objects onto the playing area before, during or after a contest.
- 8. Entering the playing area before and during a contest, including the awards ceremony, if applicable. Spectators may not enter the playing area after a contest prior to team handshakes or the opponents' safe return to their team area.
