Dear Parents of the Class of 2017:

I would like to take this opportunity to extend to you and your son or daughter a warm welcome to Las Lomas High School. The following is our schedule for registering students who will be entering Las Lomas as freshman in the fall of 2013. (Please note: proof of residency must be provided for every student entering Las Lomas. This process will begin in August)

- <u>Tuesday, January 29th</u>: Counselors visit classes at WCI and distribute registration packets and information on required courses and elective choices. The packet will include: (1) Forms to be filled out and returned the following week to WCI English classes. (2) Information related to course selection to be used for planning the 9th grade. (3) Instructions for completing the online course request system. Your student should bring this packet home for you to review and take to the evening orientation.
- <u>Tuesday, January 29th</u>: Online information link for new students launches on Las Lomas webpage <u>www.acalanes.k12.ca.us/laslomas</u>. Just look for the "New Student Info" button. This link should help you, as an incoming Las Lomas parent, feel like you are already part of our community! There are pages that answer questions about everything from Tri-S to Key Dates for the year to LLHS Bell Schedules. Please read it all and then print out what you need. Further information will be sent to you in the regular mail throughout the spring and summer as well as by emails.
- <u>Tuesday, January 29th^t- Thursday February 7th:</u> Online course request window. After discussing class selections with your student, you must enter those choices and alternate selections online. Instructions are included in the Registration Folder.
- Thursday, January 31st, 7:00pm: Eighth grade *parent only* orientation meeting at Las Lomas gym. Very important meeting reviewing and addressing questions regarding 9th grade course requirements and elective courses. Please bring with you the registration folder your student brought home on January 29th. You should leave this meeting with a rough draft of course selections. Please review course selection guidelines on the back of this sheet.
- Thursday February 7th: Registration forms are due in English classes at WCI.
- Friday, March 1st thru Friday, March 22nd: Individual counselor appointments with student and parents to discuss schedule, transition to high school and the beginnings of a four year plan. The appointment time and date will be on a sticker on the cover of the folder your student received at WCI on January 29th. We have a few early morning appointments that begin from 6:50am to 7:10am if those times would work for you please e-mail bchastain@acalanes.k12.ca.us to arrange to change your given appointment. **
- Monday, May 6th, 7:00pm: Sports Information Evening at Las Lomas Gym
- <u>Thursday, May 16th, 7:00pm</u>: Las Lomas Open House. Eighth graders and parents are encouraged to attend. Classroom demonstrations, art exhibits, musical entertainment are only a few of the exciting things planned for that evening.

Monies paid into this account may only be used for purchases in the Cafeteria. This system allows students to use the funds they have available. It does not allow negative balances.

If your child has qualified for a free or reduced-priced meal, this information is securely contained within the system and the meal will be processed the same. Applications must be completed for each new school year.

1. Who is the Principal?

6. When is the library open?

The library is open at 7:30 every morning and closes at 5:45 every weekday afternoon.

7. When is the computer lab open?

The computer lab, which is located in room 203, is opened at 7:30 every morning and closes at 4:00 every afternoon. The computer lab supervisor is Michael McEwen.

8. Who is my student's Guidance Counselor?

Ms. Ade Villasenor-Melgoza (A-Cha), Ms. Hanalee Washburn (Che-Hi), Ms. Kara Bloodgood (Ho-Me), Head Counselor-Mr. Scott Swain (Mi-Se), Ms. Valerie Wright-Smith (Sh-Z). These alpha groups are subject to change and will not be finalized until TRI-S in August.

9. Who are the Parent Advisors?

10. What is the phone number for attendance?

(925) 280-3923 or 280-3920 Ext. 2111 is used to clear absences, tardies, and request permits to leave campus.

11. Who is my student's Associate Principal?

12. What sports teams are at Las Lomas and when are their seasons?

13. How many clubs are there at Las Lomas?

There are many clubs, which change from year to year. For a current list see Mr. Wallace in the Main Office.

14 Can you choose your student's teachers?

No, the schedule determines who your student's teachers will be.

15. Is there a "late start" day?

Yes, every Wednesday, "A" period starts at 7:45am and first period starts at 8:35am.

16. If your student is struggling who do you go to for help?

First contact the teacher, second the counselor, and third the appropriate Associate Principal. The best way to contact any staff member is by email (1st initial, full last name @acalanes.k12.ca.us for example to contact the principal, Matthew Campbell, you would email mcampbell@acalanes.k12.ca.us.

17. Is attendance and being to class on time important?

Yes, because after a number of tardies, your child will be referred to detention or Saturday School. After 4 cuts your child will be referred to SARB (Student Attendance Review Board).

18. What do all visitors need to do when they come on to campus?

Any visitor, which is defined as someone who is not a student or campus personnel, is required to sign in at the Main Office before entering the campus. Las Lomas is a closed campus during school hours and visitors must have prearranged appointments. Please respect this rule for the safety of our students and staff.

19. Where are the Main Office, Attendance Office and Counseling Office?


