- Submit this completed application when buying tickets/bus assignments
- Guests must be accompanied by a current Acalanes High School junior.
 - **The guest must show a current photo I.D. Card;** only 1 guest per Acalanes student.
- Guests may not be in middle school or over the age of 21. If a guest is out of High School, attending college or working, a copy of his/her California Driver's License is required AND approval of an Acalanes administrator is required.
- Behavior at school dances will be closely monitored. Possession of or being under the influence of any controlled substance (such as alcohol, tobacco products or drugs) is prohibited. Such behavior will be dealt with according to the school's discipline code and reported to the police. A breathalyzer will be used upon entering and exiting the Prom as well as randomly throughout the evening.

By signing below, all parties agree to abide by Acalanes High School rules and regulations and also indicate an understanding that all students will travel to and from the event via bus transportation originating from, and returning to, the Acalanes parking lot. Parent/Guardian signatures give permission for student to attend the AHS Junior Prom at the *Blackhawk Auto Museum on April 22, 2017.*

Prom FAQs

When and Where is the Junior Prom?

The prom will be held on Saturday, April 22, 2017 at the Blackhawk Automotive Museum. Students are to report to the Acalanes parking lot no later than 5:45 pm. They will board buses and will return to the parking lot by 10:45 pm.

When can students purchase tickets and how much are they?

Tickets are available for purchase (cash or check) at lunch in the quad in front of the main office Monday, March 27th-Friday, March 31st and then again April 10-14th. Tickets are also available on the AHS Webstore beginning March 16th. If purchased by 3/31, tickets are \$85. After 3/31, ticket price increases to \$100

What does the ticket price include?

The Junior Prom is an all-inclusive event. The ticket includes round trip bus transportation from Acalanes High School, dinner, dancing, informal photos and entertainment.

Can my student purchase a ticket for his/her date?

Yes. Each student can purchase a maximum of 2 tickets. Students are not expected to purchase a ticket for their dates. Everyone is encouraged to purchase his or her own ticket.

My student is bringing a guest who does not attend Acalanes. How do they purchase a ticket for their guest?

Students bringing a guest from another high school must complete the Permission/Guest Pass form and purchase the ticket for their guest. Permission/Guest Pass forms can be downloaded from the AHS website or the webstore. Guest Passes must be signed by the guest's home high school administrator.

Can students other than Junior Class members attend the Prom?

Students from other grades can only attend the Prom as a guest of a Junior class member.

Does my student need anything other than a ticket?

YES. There are important forms that need to be downloaded, completed, signed and submitted to the Ticket Sales Volunteers the week of March 27-31 or April 10-14. They are available for download on the AHS website or the webstore.

If a student from another high school is attending as a guest of an Acalanes student, they must complete the Guest Pass portion on the Permission form.

Where does the student turn in the required forms?

All completed forms must be turned in to the Ticket Sales table in the front quad March 27-31 or April 10-14 at lunch. Tickets will not be distributed to any student who does not turn in all completed and signed forms.

Can my student provide his or her own transportation?

NO. All students must ride the bus. Check-in begins at 5:45 pm and buses will depart promptly at 6:00 pm. The buses do not wait for late check-ins. Students with school sponsored or religious conflict may contact Principal Travis Bell to request an exception.

All students must return on the bus to Acalanes and buses will return to Acalanes by 10:45 pm. Students with a California Provisional License should make transportation arrangements home from Acalanes.

How are students assigned to a bus?

Bus selection occurs at the same time that students turn in their permission forms during lunch March 27-31 or April 10-14. Each student can sign up with friends and can choose a bus as they remain available. The bus selection is first come first serve. If the student is bringing a date, they must sign up for the same bus.

What is a ticket is purchased and the student cannot come?

Refunds will be made up until April 13, 2017. After that date, all tickets are non-refundable.

What will the students have for dinner?

Our students will enjoy a buffet style dinner that includes a choice of a nacho bar, carving station, hot pasta station, fluffy mashed potatoes and a dessert bar. Please submit any dietary restrictions to gen.topping@gmail.com

What is the dress code?

The prom is a formal event. Gentleman may choose to wear a suit or a tuxedo. Ladies generally wear short evening dresses, but long dresses are acceptable.

Do students purchase a corsage or boutonniere for their date?

Corsages and boutonnieres are traditional. Please consider wrist corsages.

Who chaperones the Prom and what security is at the venue?

Student safety is of utmost importance. Acalanes administration and faculty, along with several Acalanes parent chaperones provide security at the Prom. All students will take a Breathalyzer test prior to boarding the bus.

Are scholarships available?
