WHY?

WHAT?

The idea of “1-1 Learning” includes District-Provided Devices and the “Bring Your Own Device” (BYOD) Program. The recommended BYOD minimum system specifications are:

- ◆ Connect to the Internet through 5GHz Wi-Fi
- ◆ Have at least 5 hours of battery life
- ◆ Headphones
- ◆ Multimedia creation and editing capabilities
- ◆ 7 inch screen

***NOTE: Smartphones and e-readers do not meet our recommended BYOD Minimum Requirements**

HOW?

How are we currently utilizing BYOD at Campolindo?

- ◆ Students access, create and use instructional material via Google Apps for Education.
- ◆ Students collaborate and communicate with teacher and other students
- ◆ Students pose questions and initiate their own research
- ◆ Students engage with material
- ◆ Students access online textbooks and novels, which allows them to interact with difficult texts
