

2013-2014 APR System

Prior to 2013-2014, the California Department of Education (CDE) reported results for both state and federal accountability requirements, which included information about the state, LEAs, schools and numerically significant student groups using an integrated approach system called the Accountability Progress Reporting (APR). 2014 AYP Report

The CDE will continue to make AYP determinations for high schools and high school LEAs having enrollment in grades nine, ten, eleven and twelve. The AYP determinations will be based on achievement results from the grade ten California High School Exit Examination (CAHSEE) and California Alternate Performance Assessment (CAPA), as well as the cohort graduation rate.

The following are required AYP indicators for the 2014 AYP reports:

- Participation rate, and
- Annual Measurable Objectives (AMOs), also known as percent proficient, and
- Graduation Rate

Elimination of the API as an Additional Indicator

The 2014 Smarter Balanced Field Test did not generate assessment results. Therefore, the State Board of Education approved to suspend the API for the 2014 Growth, 2014 Base and 2015 Growth reports.

Changes to the Graduation Rate

For the 2014 AYP, the four-year cohort graduation rate will be used. The school or LEA and all numerically significant student groups will be required to meet the graduation criteria for an ELA or school to make AYP in 2014.

AYP Targets Increase for 2014

In 2014, the AYP targets increased to 100 percent. Therefore, high schools and high school LEAs receiving an AYP report, the requirement is for 100 percent of students to be proficient or above in English-Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics.















California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress

CAASPP System Overview

The California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) System was established on January 1, 2014. The CAASPP System replaces the Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) Program which became inoperative on July 1, 2013.

For 2014-2015, the CAASPP System encompasses the following assessments and student participation requirements.

- Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments for English-Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics in grades three through eight and eleven. All AUHSD eleventh graders will be required to participate with the exception of students who participate in the alternate assessments
 California Alternate Performance Assessment (CAPA) or California Modified Assessment (CMA).
 English learners who are in their first 12 months of attending a school in the United States will be exempt from the ELA portion of the CAASPP System.
- Alternate assessments for English-Language Arts and mathematics in grades three through eight
 and eleven. This alternative assessment will be available to students with significant cognitive
 disabilities who are unable to take the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments even with
 accessibility supports and whose IEP indicates assessment with an alternate test.
- Science assessments in grades five, eight and ten (i.e., California Standards Tests (CST), CMA and CAPA). This will be a paper-pencil test based on the California content standards based on 1998 adopted science standards.
- Standards-based tests in Spanish (STS) for reading/language arts in grades two through eleven (optional).

Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments

The Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments will be delivered by computer and consist of two sections: a computer-adaptive test and a Performance Task based on the Common Core State Standards for English-language arts and mathematics. The questions range in types of items and include selected response, constructed response, table, fill-in, graphing, etc. The Performance Tasks are extended activities that measure a student's ability to integrate knowledge and skills across multiple standards – a key component of college and career readiness.


On September 4, 2013, the State Board of Education adopted the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) for California Public Schools, Kindergarten through Grade Twelve (Ed Code 60605.85) The NGSS Appendices were also adopted to assist teachers in the implementation of the new science standards and to aid in the development of the new science curriculum framework. The California Department of Education is developing assessments based on the NGSS.

During the transition to new science assessments, the 2014-15 CAASPP System encompasses federally required science assessments in grades 5, 8, and 10 (i.e.: California Standards Tests (CST), California Modified Assessment (CMA) and California Alternate Performance Assessment (CAPA)).

As per the federal requirement, the Life Science California Standards Test was administered to all AUHSD tenth graders during the April 2014 CAASPP administration.

About the ACT College Entrance Exams

The ACT (no writing) consists of four multiple-choice tests: English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science. The ACT Plus Writing includes the four multiple-choice tests and a writing test.

Test			Content

Mathematics	60 questions	60 minutes	Measures mathematical skills students have typically acquired in courses taken up to the beginning of grade 12.





Mathematics Course Value Added to ACT Mathematics


Science Course Value Added to ACT Science
