

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The California State University

15 units listed below completed with grades of C or better. Admission is based on an index of 10-12 GPA and test scores (SAT or ACT).

- 2 years: Social Science, including one year of US History or US History and Government
- 4 years: English
- 3 years: Mathematics (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II)
- 2 years: Science with lab (one year biological and one year physical)
- 2 years: Foreign language (same language)
- 1 year: Visual and Performing Arts
- 1 year: Elective in college prep course

SAT Reasoning Test or ACT is also required for admission

The University of California

Complete the 15 units listed below with grades of C or better and have a minimum 3.0 wtd. GPA in 10-12 coursework.

- a. History/Social Science: 2 years required, including one year of world history, geography and one year of US History or one-half year of US History and one-half year of Government
- b. English: 4 years required
- c. Mathematics: 3 years required, 4 years recommended, to include Algebra, Geometry, Algebra II
- d. Lab Science: 2 years required, 3 years recommended, in both physical and biological sciences
- e. Foreign Language: 2 years required, 3 years recommended, in the same language
- f. Visual and Performing Art: 1 year required
- g. Elective: 1 year required of College Prep elective

SAT Reasoning Test/ACT with Writing are also required.

Subject Tests are not required but are recommended in certain majors.

Out of State/Private Colleges

Most colleges follow the admission requirements listed above for our California public schools.

However, many out of state public schools now require **three years of science**, including Oregon, Arizona, Colorado, and Nevada.
