

Class of 2017 Acalanes High School Senior Memory Frames

What?

A senior memory frame is a beautiful photo collage highlighting the life of each senior, to be created by the student and/or parent. The frames are 12" wide x 18" tall and **need to be pre-ordered for \$10 on the AHS Webstore by February 1st, 2017**. You will find it under classes by graduating year/2017 Seniors. Samples can be viewed on the APC website.

When?

We will distribute the blank frames to you before/after the Senior Parent Night in the Spring of 2017. After that date you may pick up your pre-ordered frame in the College and Career Center (CCC). **Completed frames should be returned to the CCC by Friday, June 2nd, 2017.**

How?

Use as many photos as you want and arrange your collage **vertically**. Please **incorporate your child's first and last name on the front of the collage** and put your name and phone number on the back. Please copy all photos in case your student's frame is lost or damaged. You may also create your collage digitally online through Costco, Staples and Click-Scan-Share, just to name a few. It only costs a few dollars for a 12 x 18 print, so you can make an extra for your grad to take to college or for the grandparents.

Where?

The frames will be displayed vertically, by alphabet, on the fence behind the bleachers on graduation day, **Friday, June 9th**. **Please pick up your frame directly after graduation day and take it home with you.**

What else?

If you turn in your frame late, we will make every effort to display it, however it may not get placed in alphabetical order.

Frames that are left behind on graduation day will be moved into the college and career office and can be picked up the following Monday.
