Attendance and Behavior Policy

For Students Concurrently Enrolled in High School Classes

Please Note:

- There is no fee for any of the courses.
- There is no registration by telephone or fax.
- You will not receive a confirmation from the Adult Education office.

Expectations:

1. Concurrent enrollment in Adult Secondary Education classes is voluntary to meet graduation requirements.
2. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated, as outlined in signed agreement.
3. Students are responsible for completing class hours, course work and laboratory sessions. Student will discuss any difficulties with teacher and/or high school counselor.
4. Students adhere to absence and tardy policy, which requires 85% attendance.
5. Students and parents understand that more than half of the class is to be composed of adults and that enrollment may be limited by this requirement.
6. In order to receive credit, students must attend laboratory sessions.

Discipline:

Any student not meeting behavior expectations will be referred to the night administrator when available. Otherwise the referral will be dealt with the next day and the student's home school will be notified. The parent/guardian will be notified of the referral and disciplinary action taken (i.e. possible removal from Adult School). The Education Code 48900 relating to suspension and expulsion will be enforced.

Absence and Tardy Policy:

Tardy = 0 to 10 minutes of missed classroom time
3 tardies = 1 absence; 6 tardies = 2 absences

Students will be dropped for any of the following:

- ✓ 2 absences
- ✓ 6 tardies
- ✓ 1 absence and 3 tardies
