## CSF Semester Membership Application Worksheet

The CSF application will be completed online for the Fall 2025 semester (based upon grades earned **from last spring semester**). Prior to completing the online application, please review the information below as this will help you enter your information both accurately and quickly.

To qualify for CSF membership this semester, please review the information below:

1) **You must earn a minimum of 10 points** based upon last semester's (Spring 2024) grades

- **The first 4 points** must be from LIST I (see second page for course lists)
- **The first 7 points** (including the four points described above) must be from LISTS I and II
- The remaining points may come from any LIST I, II, or III

2) You may not use more than 5 courses to qualify

3) No CSF points are given for Physical Education classes, TA/Peer Tutor courses, or classes graded as P/NP

4) CSF points are granted as follows:

- Grade of A = 3 CSF points
- Grade of B = 1 CSF point
- One additional point shall be granted for a grade of 'A' or 'B' in an AP or Honors course, up to a maximum of two points per semester
- Grade of C = 0 CSF points
- Receiving a grade of 'D' or 'F' in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership for this semester
