The CSF application will be completed online for the Spring 2023 semester (based upon grades earned <u>from last fall semester</u>). Prior to completing the online application, please review the information below as this will help you enter your information both accurately and quickly.

### To qualify for CSF membership this semester, please review the information below:

- 1) You must earn a minimum of 10 points based upon last semester's (Fall 2022) grades.
  - The first 4 points must be from <u>LIST I</u> (see second page for course lists)
  - The first 7 points (including the four points described above) must be from LISTS I and II
  - The remaining points may come from any LIST I, II, or III.
- 2) You may not use more than 5 courses to qualify.
- 3) No CSF points are given for Physical Education classes, TA/Peer Tutor courses, or classes graded as P/NP.
- 4) CSF points are granted as follows:
  - Grade of A = 3 CSF points
  - Grade of B = 1 CSF point
  - One additional point shall be granted for a grade of 'A' or 'B' in an AP or Honors course, up to a maximum of two points per semester
  - Grade of C = 0 CSF points
  - Receiving a grade of 'D' or 'F' in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership for this semester
