I want to begin by thanking you all for your feedback, support, and patience as we have worked together through this unprecedented school closure. Las Lomas will still bring the fun!

We are excited to let you know that we will distribute caps and gowns next week at our Pick-Up Party. **Tuesday, May 19th from 1:00 - 3:15 pm** students will be able to pick up their caps and gowns, and a few other treats, in the senior parking lot at Las Lomas. Pick-up times are arranged by last name, and we ask that students or parents time arrivals according to the following schedule. Please do your best to arrive according to the schedule, as we have planned our pickups to be no contact and make this experience as convenient for you as possible.

1:00 - 1:45PM: Students with the last name A - K

1:45 - 2:30 PM: Students with the last name L - Q

2:30 - 3:15 PM: Students with the last name R - Z

To minimize contact during the pick-up process please:

- Place an 8.5"x11" piece of paper on the passenger side dashboard with your student's name (last name, first name) printed clearly in large letters.
- Have either the back window down or trunk popped for easy access so no hand to hand contact is necessary.
- If you are not driving, you may walk on to campus and pick up your materials in front of the main office. Please wear a mask.

It is extremely important to remember that we are still in a Shelter in Place mandate, and students and parents should remain in their cars while they pick up their cap and gown.

Those who have arranged to borrow a cap and gown, this is also included in this pick-up. In addition, senior panoramic pictures and CSF materials will be distributed at this time.
