### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR COURSE REGISTRATION 2023-2024**

#### **Guidelines for Selecting Courses**

Please review the AUHSD Course Catalog before choosing your courses. You are encouraged to consider the following course selection guidelines when planning an overall schedule:

- 1. **Graduation Requirements** Carefully check the AUHSD graduation requirements.
- 2. College Entrance Requirements Consider taking courses required by colleges and universities.
- 3. Interests Look for courses that are interesting and relevant to college and career goals.
- 4. **Overall Course Schedule** Examine the overall rigor of a potential schedule.
- 5. **Parent/Guardian Approval –** Talk to parents/guardians about course options.
- 6. **Teacher/Counselor Guidance** Seek input from teachers and counselors about a class schedule.

#### **Instructions for Course Registration**

#### Complete the Worksheet (see back)

- 1. Print your name in the space provided above.
- 2. Complete the worksheet on the back **BEFORE** you select classes in the online Aeries Pass Portal.
- 3. You must sign up for at least 6 courses; however, you may request 7. Review the courses available for your grade level on the back of this worksheet.
- 4. List your requested courses on the worksheet. You must also list alternate courses in case a specific course is not available. Required courses are already listed.
- 5. Several semester-long courses are available to grade 11 students. If you are interested in semester-long classes, see the options below:
  - A. Option 1: Select 2 semester-long courses or
  - B. Option 2: Select 1 semester-long course and "Off Campus". The "Off Campus" option is only available to students enrolled in at least 6 year-long courses.

#### **Online Registration**

- 1. Using the "Quick Links" dropdown menu on your high school's website, choose the Aeries Pass Portal.
- 2. Log in with your "auhsdschools.org" email and password.
- 3. Once logged in, select "Classes" then "Course Request Entry".
- 4. Use "Filter Courses" to select a "Subject Area" and your desired course.
- 5. Confirm your selection when prompted. You may also cancel your selection at this time.
- 6. The selected course will be added to the left column and an "Add Alternate" option will now be available.
- 7. To make an alternate course selection, select "Add Alternate" and select the appropriate "Subject Area". Not selecting an alternate course when necessary may delay your course selection process.
- 8. Change the "Subject Area" to make additional course selections.
