## General Rules, Mandatory Attendance, and Behavior Policies

### Summer School Dates and Times (June 11 - July 12, 2024)

- Summer School will be held over the course of five weeks.
  - 2 of the weeks will have an altered schedule because of holidays
  - June 17th week, school is in session M, T, Th, F (June 19th is a holiday, no school)
  - July 1st week, school is in session, M, T, W (July 4th & 5th are holidays, no school)
- Students will be placed in a cohort that meets either T/Th or W/F
  - **Cohort A** meets Tuesdays and Thursdays.
    - First day of class: Tuesday, June 11, 2024
    - Last day of class: Thursday, July 11, 2024
  - **Cohort B** meets Wednesdays and Fridays.
    - First day of class: Wednesday, June 12, 2024
    - Last day of class: Friday, July 12, 2024
- Each day, Period 1 will be held 8:30 a.m. - 10:00 a.m.
- Each day, Period 2 will be held 10:30 a.m. 12:00 p.m.
- Once the student completes their course(s) they are finished with summer school and no longer have to attend, this is a motivation for students to work on their courses outside of the school time.

### General Rules

- Students will take a diagnostic test at the beginning of each unit in their course.
- Students must complete **all** units of a course in order to receive credit.
- You cannot audit courses or bring visitors to class with you.

### Mandatory Attendance

- Students **must** attend in-person on their assigned cohort days.
- Students **must** be in attendance the first week of Summer School or will be dropped from the Summer School program.
- Lack of attendance on assigned cohort days and/or lack of progress in Fuel Ed course(s) may result in being dropped from assigned course(s) and Summer School program.
- **Students will take certain assessments in-person and not allowed to be taken off-site, including the final.**

### Behavior and Discipline

- Students should practice good behavior at all times. At the first class session, the instructor will provide students with information about behavior expectations.
- Students who receive a discipline referral must come to the Administration Office. The Summer School Office will notify the Parent/Guardian of the referral and the planned disciplinary action.
- Summer School will **drop** any student who receives **behavior referrals**, and will enforce Education Code 48900 related to suspension and expulsion.
- There is no distinction between summer school and regular school with respect to a school day with suspensions (AUHSD AR 5144.1 – Suspension and Expulsion / Due Process).
