Homework	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Purpose</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Primarily written work (textbook exercises, workbook exercises, worksheets); also includes preparation for vocabulary quizzes and short (paragraph-length) compositions. At this level, students receive assignments for independent (yet limited) reading, as well.</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <b>Frequency</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Assigned daily; may extended beyond one day</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <b>Feedback</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Students receive feedback from both their peers and the teacher.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	12% - 16%
Unit Tests and Quizzes, Projects (Written or Oral)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Purpose</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Chapter or unit tests (40%) and quizzes (8%-12%), including vocabulary, grammar or response to a reading.</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <b>Frequency</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ When appropriate</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <b>Feedback</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Projects may include recitation of a poem or a presentation on a topic related to a theme or structure practiced in the textbook.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	48% - 52%
Other Quantifiable Areas of Evaluation - Classwork	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Purpose</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Includes both written and oral activities completed in class as</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	12% - 16%

	<p>individuals or in small groups; as well as holistically and analytically scored assignments.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Frequency</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ One project per quarter</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <b>Feedback</b></li> </ul> <p>At this level, there are fewer informal assessments than at previous levels. Activities often focus on specific topics or structures that are being practiced in class.</p>	
Final Exam	Includes exercises for listening, speaking, reading and writing in German.	16% - 20%
