Acalanes High School Parking Policy

- \$ 0 fee is required along with student's driver's license & vehicle registration(s)
- Only Juniors and Seniors with a valid California Driver's license and a vehicle may purchase a
 parking permit. No permits will be issued to Freshman & Sophomores
- Possession of a permit does not guarantee that a parking place will be available; all spaces are available on a first-come, first- served basis
- Speed limits will be strictly enforced. Persons driving recklessly on campus will be subject to both Vehicle Code and AHS discipline code consequences
- The permit is to remain in the possession and control of the person to whom it is issued. Any fraudulent use or misuse of a permit will result in disciplinary action, including, but not limited to, revocation of the permit for up to two years and/or suspension from school
- Illegally parked cars will be cited by the Acalanes Campus Supervisor as well as the Lafayette
 Police Department, including:
 - Cars with no visible permit
 - o Cars with improper permit for that area
 - Cars parked in handicapped zones without handicapped permits
 - o Cars with permits parked illegally, e.g. fire lanes, out of designated parking places
- Permits must be hung facing forward from the rear view mirror in clear view
- There will be a \$20 charge for lost tags
- Separately designated parking areas for teachers, staff and visitors will be clearly marked
- No special regulations will be made for students who have mid-day appointments

SPECIFIC PARKING AREAS

Front lot: All permits accepted

Yellow zone in front of school: Deliveries, drop offs/pick ups: 30 minute limit

Tennis court lot: Public parking – No permit required except for marked District spaces.

North lot: Auto Shop (Student permit and special additional permit required)

Back area: Staff only

Along Pleasant Hill Rd: Staff only

NO PARKING AT FIRST STEPS LEARNING CENTER OR LIVING HOPE FELLOWSHIP CHURCH ON STANLEY BLVD.

Single-day permits for visitors are available for extended visits.

AHS Parking policy is also enforced by the Lafayette Police Department.
