ACALANES CLASS OF 2019 GRAD NIGHT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

OBJECTIVE: To provide a fun, safe, sober, and drug free night for the Acalanes Class of 2019 to celebrate graduation.

REQUIREMENTS: Each participating student and the parents/guardians of each participating student shall sign an Authorization Form which includes three agreements: a) Code of Conduct Agreement, including a Consent to Search all property and clothes which the student seeks to wear into Grad Night; b) Medical Authorization Form; c) Release and Waiver of Liability Form.

No student will be admitted without the signed agreements on the file in the school office. Please note that all three agreements are on the attached Authorization Form pages.

ADMISSION AND DEPARTURES:

- Check in will begin at 7:30 p.m. on Friday June 7, 2019 in the cafeteria and will continue until 8:15 p.m. Buses will begin departure for the Umigo Racing in Livermore at 8:30 p.m.

- An attempt will be made to notify parents if any student for whom we have a signed form fails to check in for admission. Each participating student and the parents of guardians of each participation student agree that once checked in, the student shall remain at Grad Night until the conclusion at 4:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 8, 2019. In case of illness, the student will only be released to a parent or guardian that can show proof of I.D.

- Buses will be leave the Umigo Racing approximately at 3:30 a.m. on Saturday, June 8, 2019 and should arrive at Acalanes by 4:00 a.m. We *strongly* encourage parents/guardians to pick up their student in the Acalanes parking lot at 4:00 a.m.

PERSONAL PROPERTY: No personal property will be allowed on the bus to the Grad Night party with the exception of a cell phone. Students will be given time after Graduation to change into other clothing if they wish. Parents should take all this property home. Please leave any valuables at home. Students will need to have closed toed shoes to race at Umigo.

ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, WEAPONS, AND DRUGS -- ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY: - The use and/or possession of alcohol, tobacco, weapons, or drugs shall not be allowed at Grad Night. This policy applies to all students as well as to all other participants, parent volunteers, vendors and contractors.

- Any person observed to be using alcohol, tobacco, or drugs, or believed to have been using alcohol or drugs at Grad Night will be asked to leave Grad Night.

- Any student participant asked to leave Grad Night will be required to remain at the Umigo until a parent, guardian or the person designated in the Medical Emergency Authorization, can pick up the student with valid proof of I.D. The student will not be allowed to return.

- Any alcohol, drugs, or weapons found on any student or in any student clothing will be confiscated and turned over to the Lafayette Police.

INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR: Any conduct that interferes with the enjoyment of others at Grad Night is inappropriate behavior. Such behavior includes, but is not limited to: fighting, roughhousing, taunting, defacing or destroying property or refusing to comply with the instructions of the Grad Night committee. Any participant whom the Grad Night committee believes to be engaging in an inappropriate behavior will be first asked to stop, and if the behavior persists or is repeated, the participant will be asked to leave. A student participant's parent/guardian or permission slip alternate adult will be called to pick up the student.
