The Food Services Department is excited to announce that we have partnered with Titan School Solutions to provide a NEW Point of Sale System!

The new system will directly affect families in the following ways:

1. Titan uses an on-line portal where families may manage their account.
2. The on-line payment vendor changes from MySchoolBucks to Titan
3. On-line applications for the National School Lunch Program may be completed through Titan's portal

The AUHSD Meal Program utilizes a point of sale (POS) system. Your student's ID number is used at the meal-line register when purchasing food. To help increase the efficiency of the lines, we strongly encourage using the "debit account" to pay for your student's meals.
