## **California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP)**

AUHSD students participated in the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) during the 2021-2022 school year. The following assessments were part of 2021-2022 CAASPP:

- Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA)
  - Summative assessment of English Language Arts/Literacy (ELA) for grade 11 students
  - Summative assessment of mathematics for grade 11 students
- California Science Test (CAST) -- Given to grade 11 and grade 12 students
- California Alternate Assessments (CAA) – Given to eligible grade 11 students for English Language Arts/Literacy (ELA), mathematics, and science (CAST)
- Standards-Based Tests in Spanish (STS) -- Optional reading/language arts assessments for grade 11 students

All assessments were delivered online and included a selected-response test and a performance task. These assessments are aligned to the California Common Core Standards in ELA/Literacy and mathematics. The science test aligns with the Next Generation Science Standards. Scores are reported for ACIS, AHS, CHS, LLHS, and MHS. Scores are not reported for AUHSD-affiliated students attending a non-public school.

## Smarter Balanced Assessment Results

- SBA is for grade 11 students
- Students eligible through their IEP to participate in a California Alternate Assessment do not take the SBA
- English learners who are in their first 12 months of attending a school in the United States are exempt from taking the ELA/Literacy SBA.
- Scores are reported for ACIS, AHS, CHS, LLHS and MHS. Scores are not reported for AUHSD-affiliated students attending a non-public school
- Four levels of achievement:
  - Standard Exceeded: Level 4
  - Standard Met: Level 3
  - Standard Nearly Met: Level 2
  - Standard Not Met: Level 1

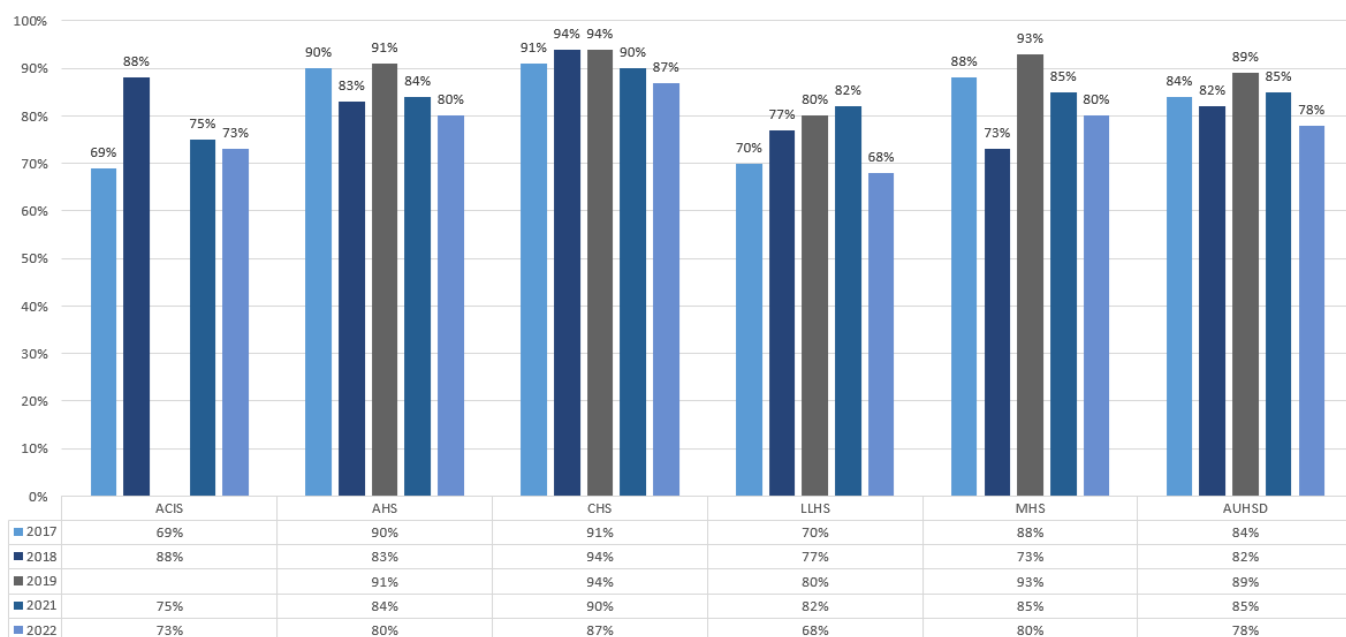

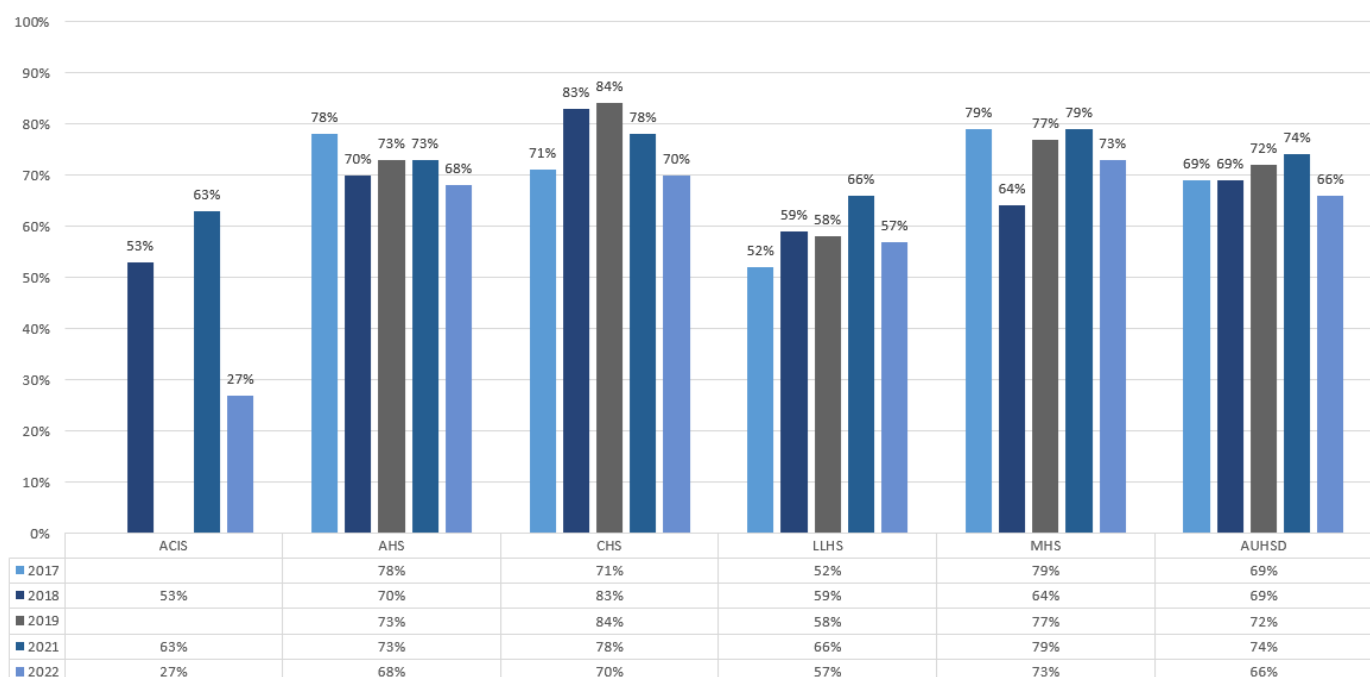

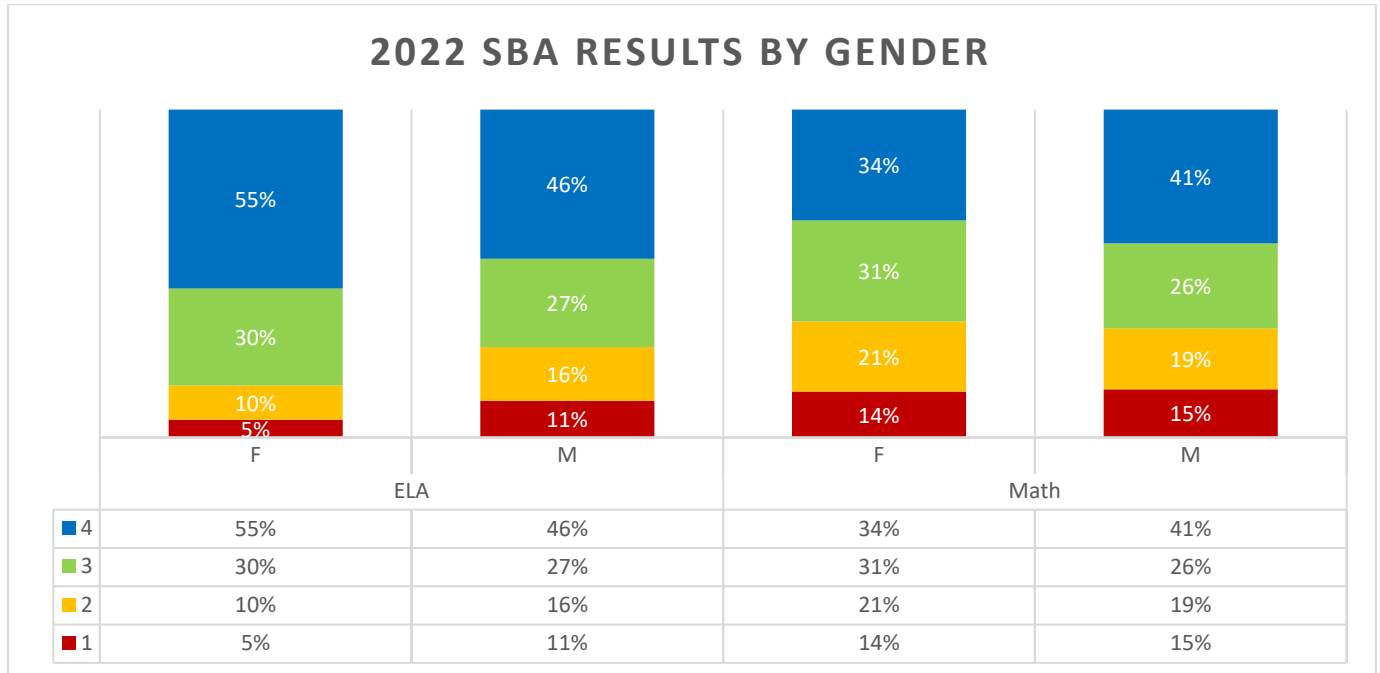

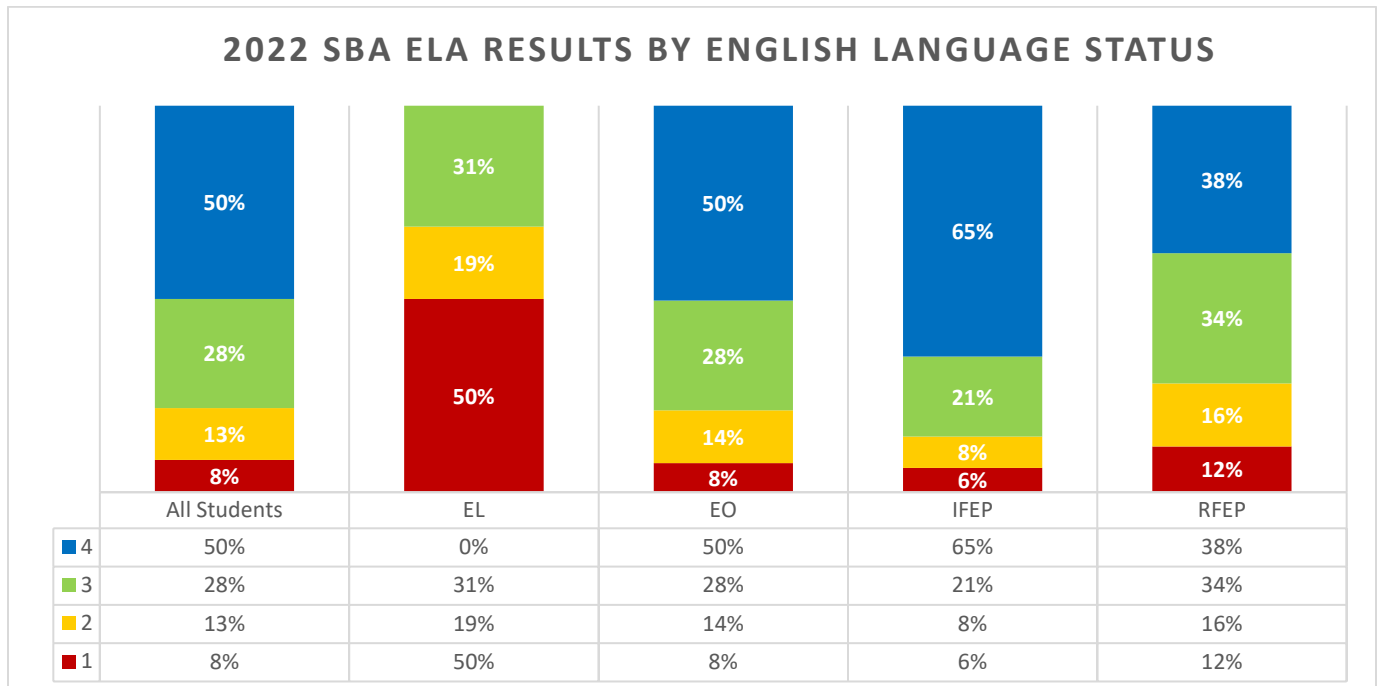

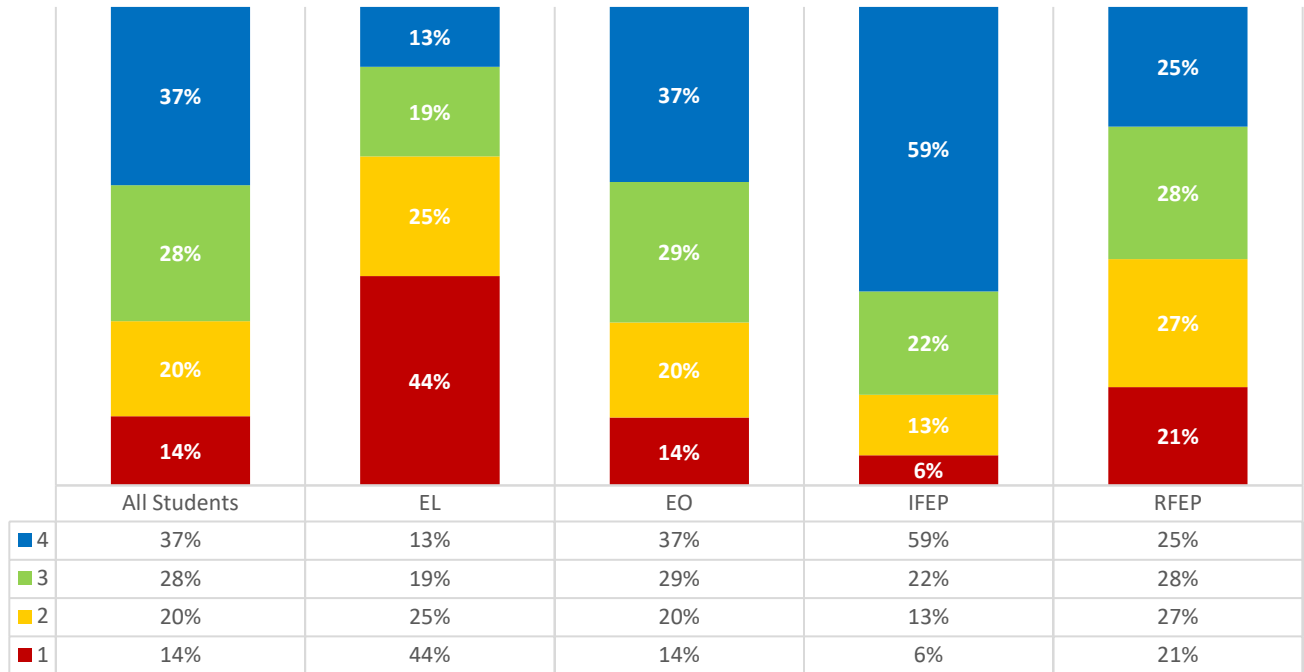

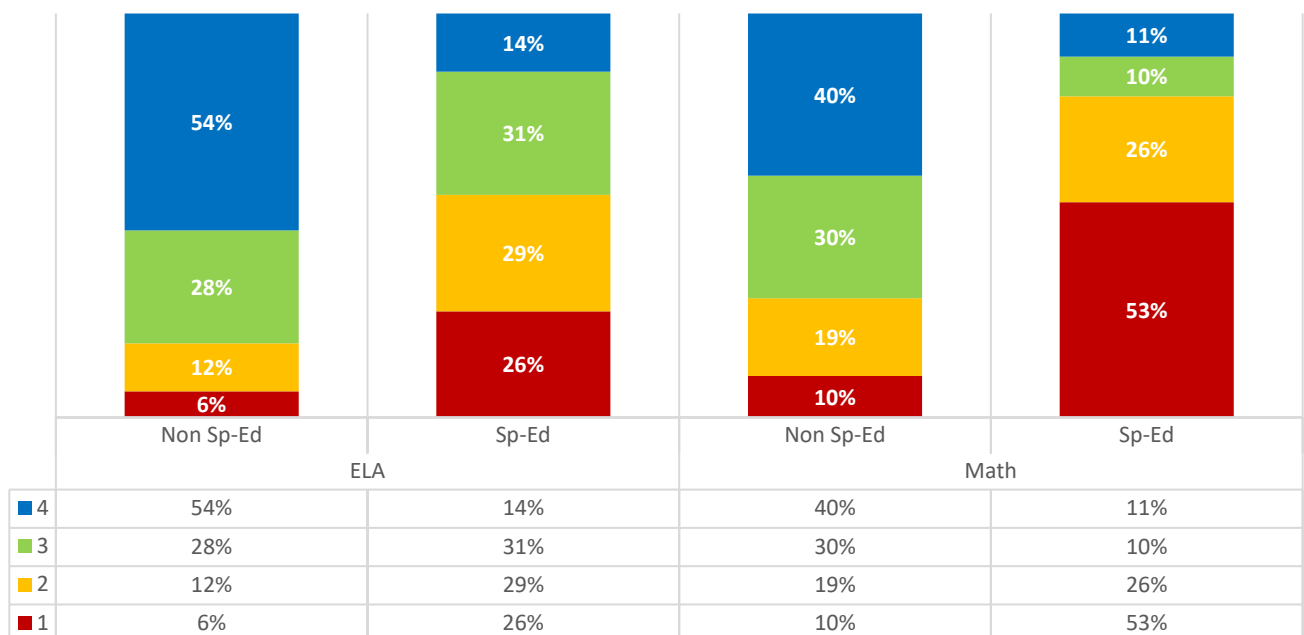


### 2022 SBA MATH RESULTS BY ENGLISH LANGUAGE STATUS

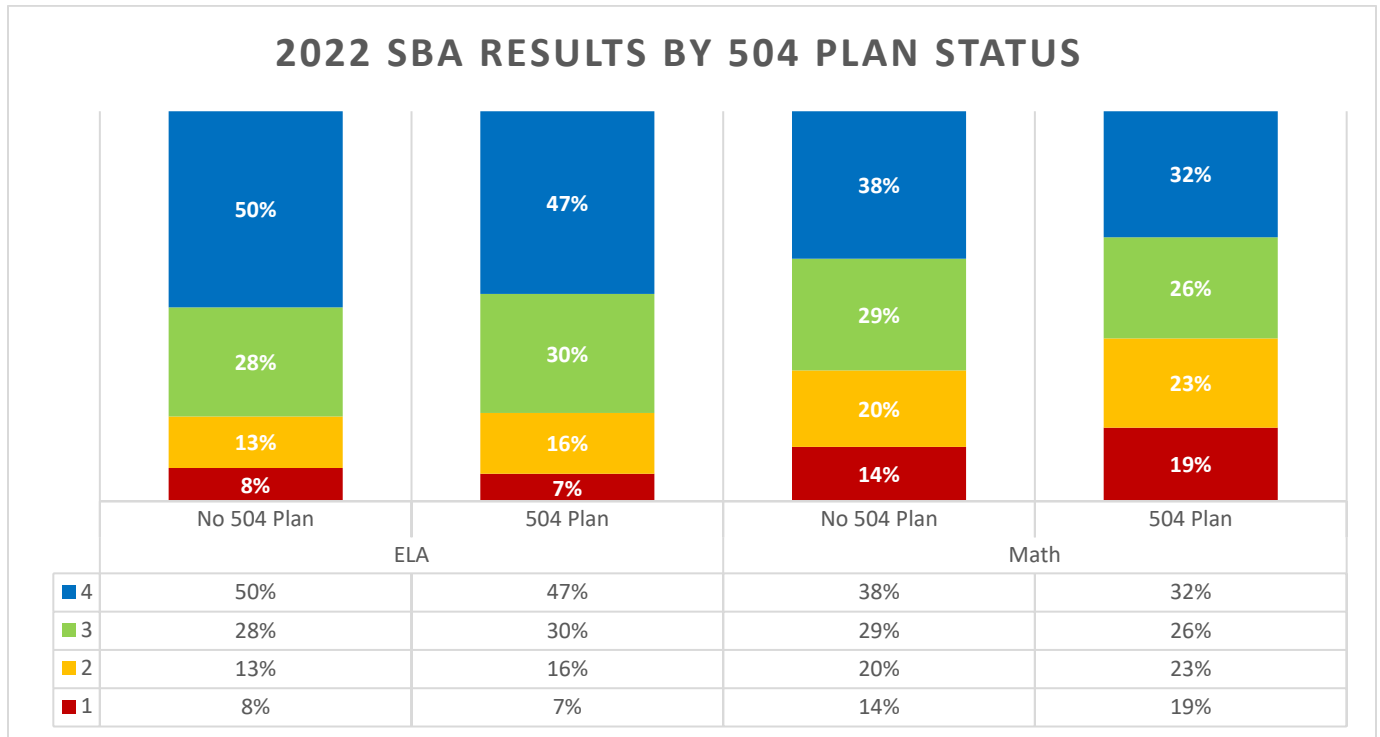

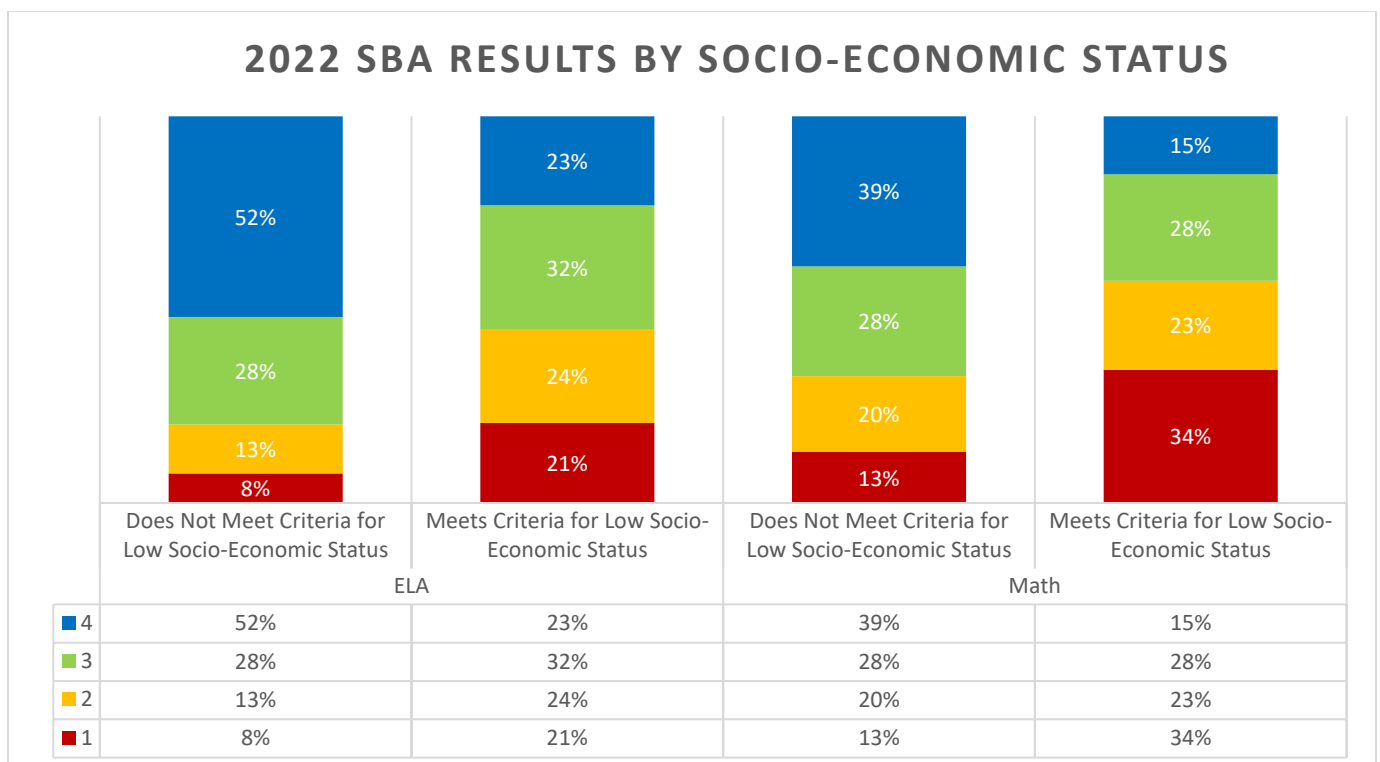
### 2022 SBA RESULTS BY SPECIAL EDUCATION STATUS

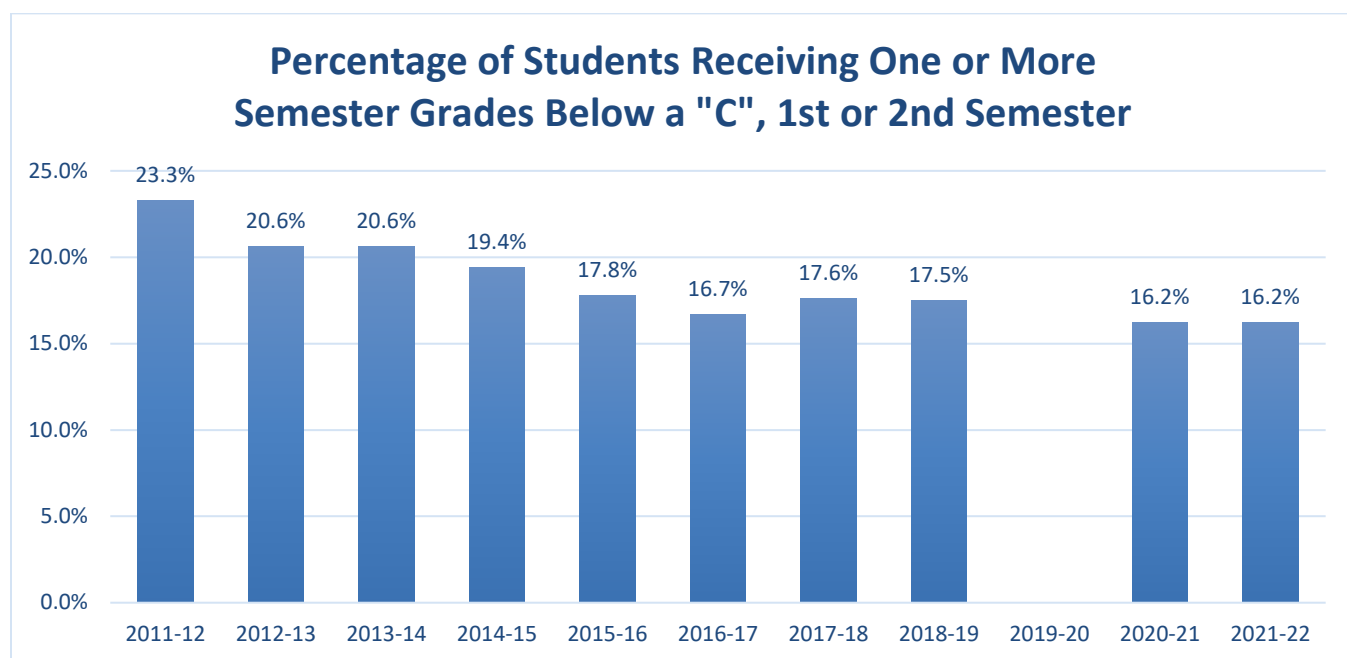

## Graduation Data

This report presents data related to the four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate. In addition to addressing the overall four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate, the report includes graduation data disaggregated by race/ethnicity and student program for all AUHSD schools. The four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate is the number of students who graduate from high school in four years with a regular high school diploma divided by the number of students who form the four-year adjusted cohort for the graduating class. The four-year adjusted cohort is based on the number of students who enter grade nine for the first time with the following adjustments: (1) Adding into the cohort any student who transfers in later during grade nine or during the next three years and (2) Subtracting any student from the cohort who transfers out, emigrates to another country, transfers to a prison or juvenile facility, or dies during that same period.

The four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate includes students earning a “regular high school diploma” and does not include students earning a general-equivalency diploma, certificate of completion, certificate of attendance, or any other similar or lesser credential, such as a diploma based on meeting Individualized Education Program (IEP) goals. Since 2016-2017, students passing a diploma equivalency test have not been included in the four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate.

The percentage of graduates who met the UC/CSU A-G course requirements, earned a State Seal of Biliteracy, or earned a Golden Seal Merit Diploma is included in this report. Details about these graduation distinctions follow:

- **Graduates Meeting the UC/CSU A-G Requirements:** Those cohort graduates who a local educational agency determines met all the (A-G) course requirements for admission to the University of California or California State University systems.
- **Graduates Earning the State Seal of Biliteracy:** Those cohort graduates who, in accordance with Education Code Section 51460(a), attain a high level of proficiency in one or more languages (including American Sign Language) in addition to English.
- **Graduates Earning a Golden State Seal Merit Diploma:** Those cohort graduates who, in accordance with Education Code Section 51454, earn the Golden State Seal Merit Diploma by meeting the following criteria: (a) Completed of all requirements for a high school diploma, and (b) Demonstrated mastery of the curriculum in at least six subject areas, four of which shall be mathematics, English language arts, science, and United States history, with the remaining two subject areas selected by the student.
