# Graduation Data: Cohort Graduation Rate

- Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate
  - Number of students in the four-year adjusted cohort who graduate in four years or less divided by number of students who form the cohort for that graduation class.
  - “Graduate from high school” – traditional high school diploma
    - This represents a change in calculation effective with 2017 cohort as it removes adult education high school diploma and successful completion of the California High School Proficiency Exam from counting as “graduating from high school”
- Adjusted cohort
  - Adding students who transfer into the cohort during grades 9 -12
  - Subtracting students who transfer out, leave the country, or pass on

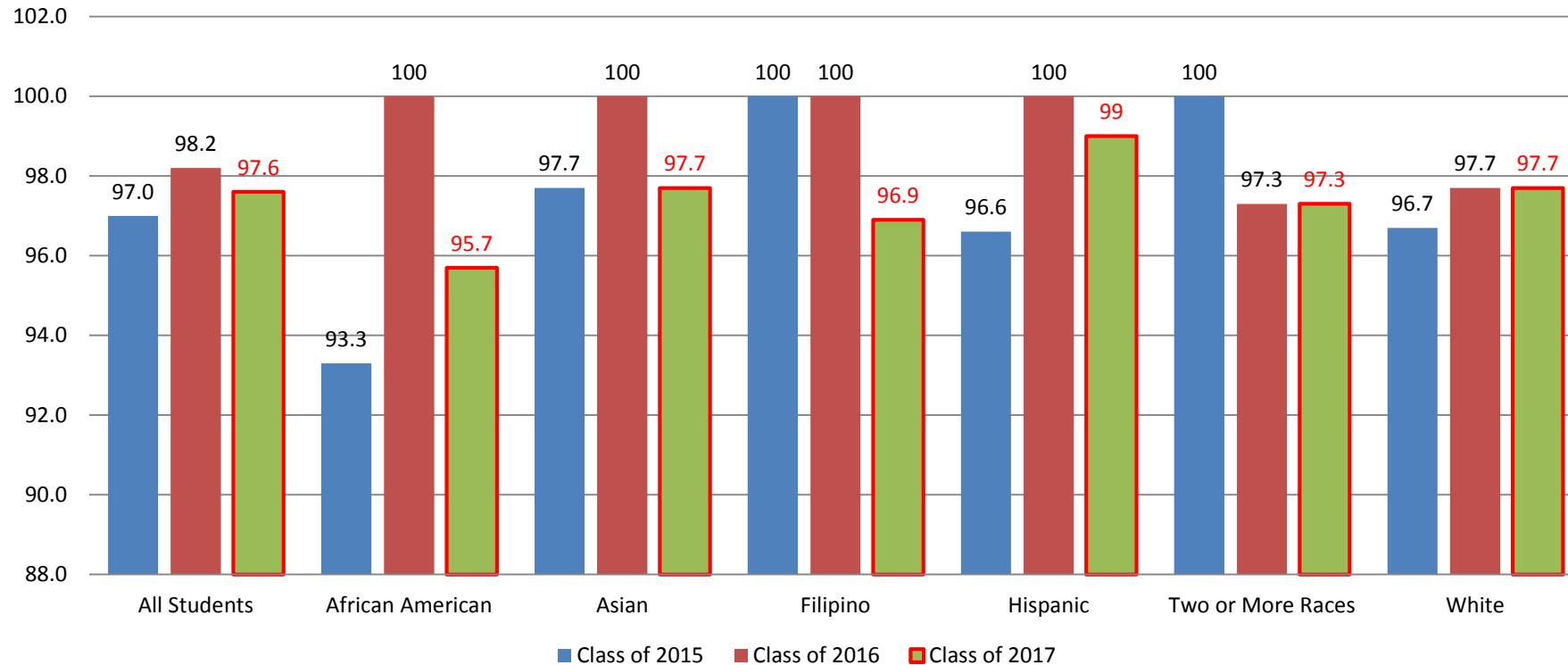

Race and Ethnicity**

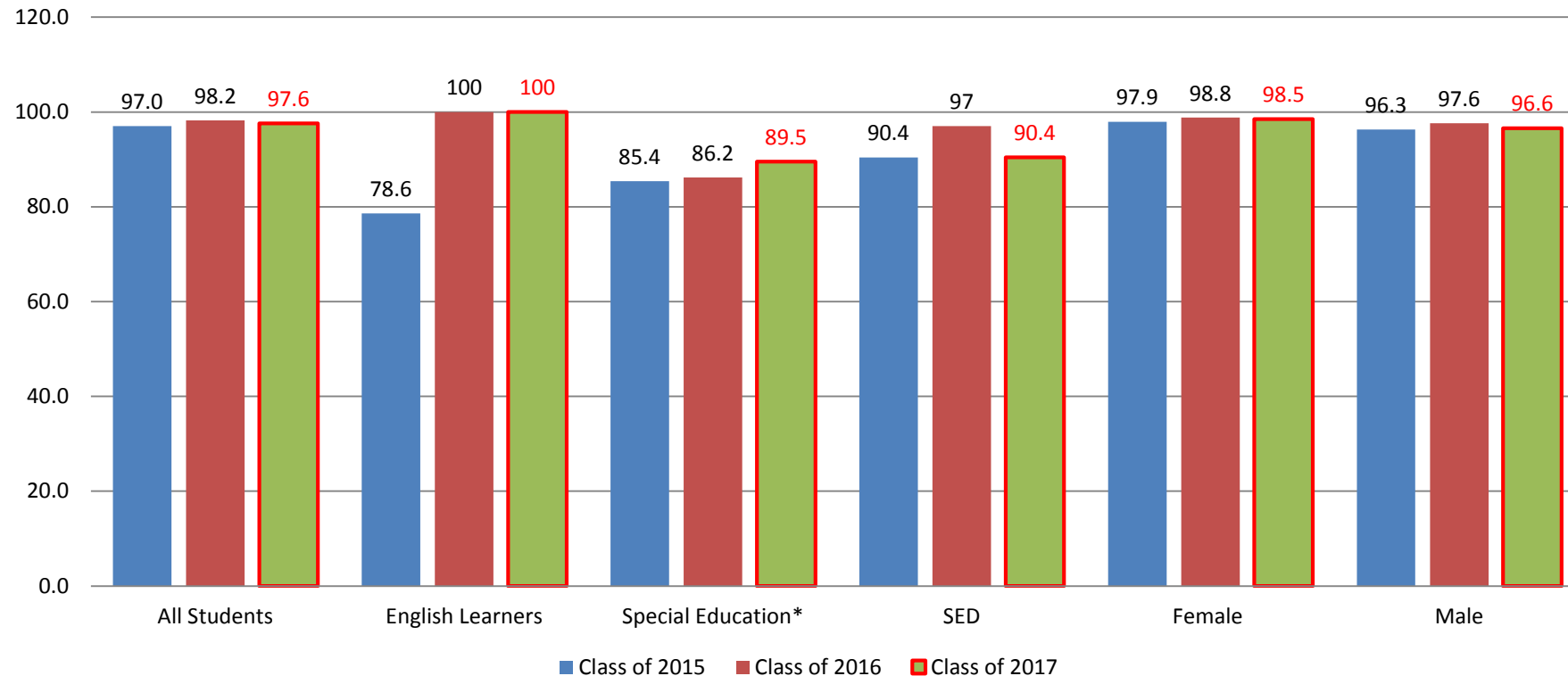

# Graduation Data: A-G Readiness

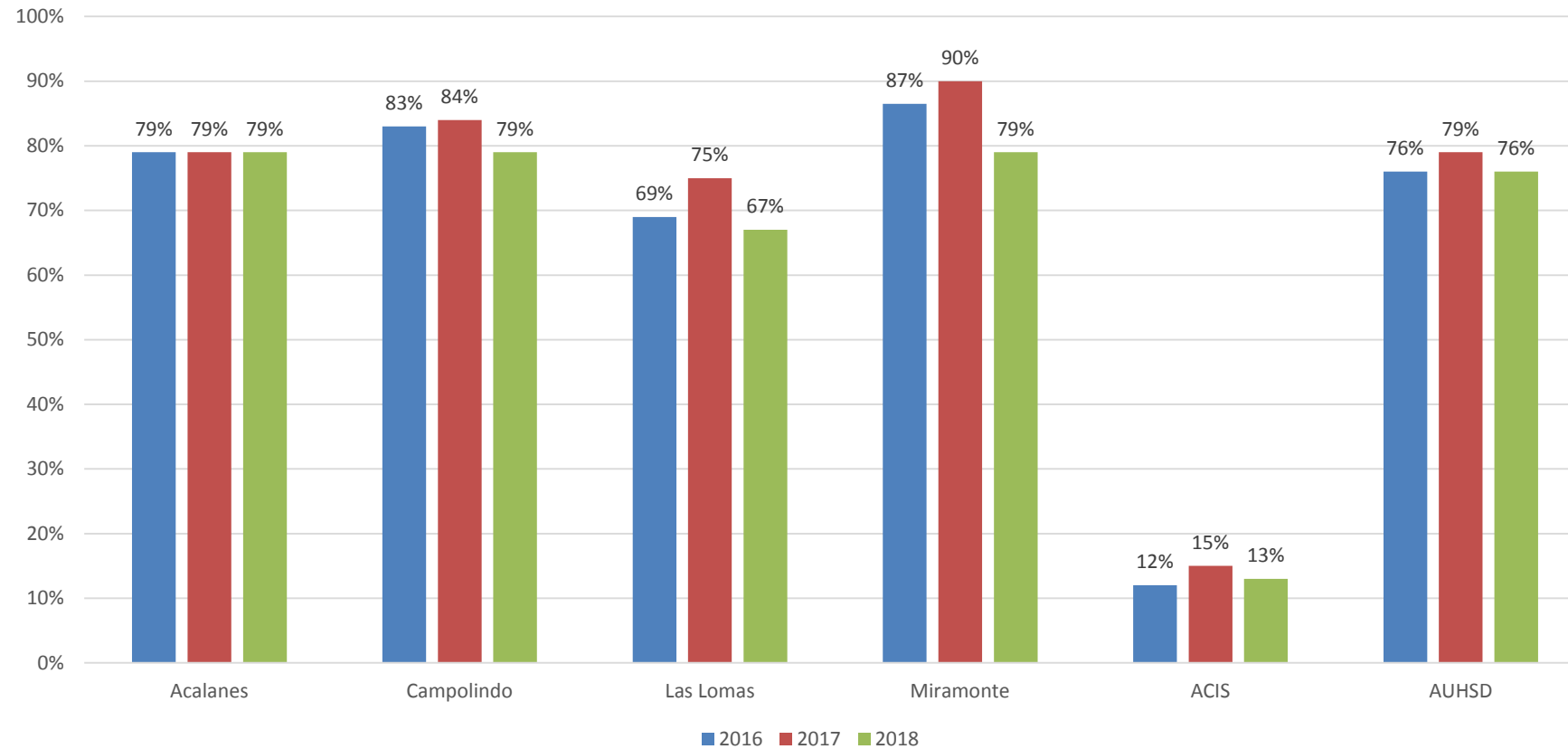
- Students are considered A-G Ready if:
  - They have completed all of the required A-G courses
  - All courses completed with a grade C or above
- A-G readiness data is being monitored in the LCAP
- A-G readiness will be part of the College and Career Readiness Indicator in the California School Dashboard





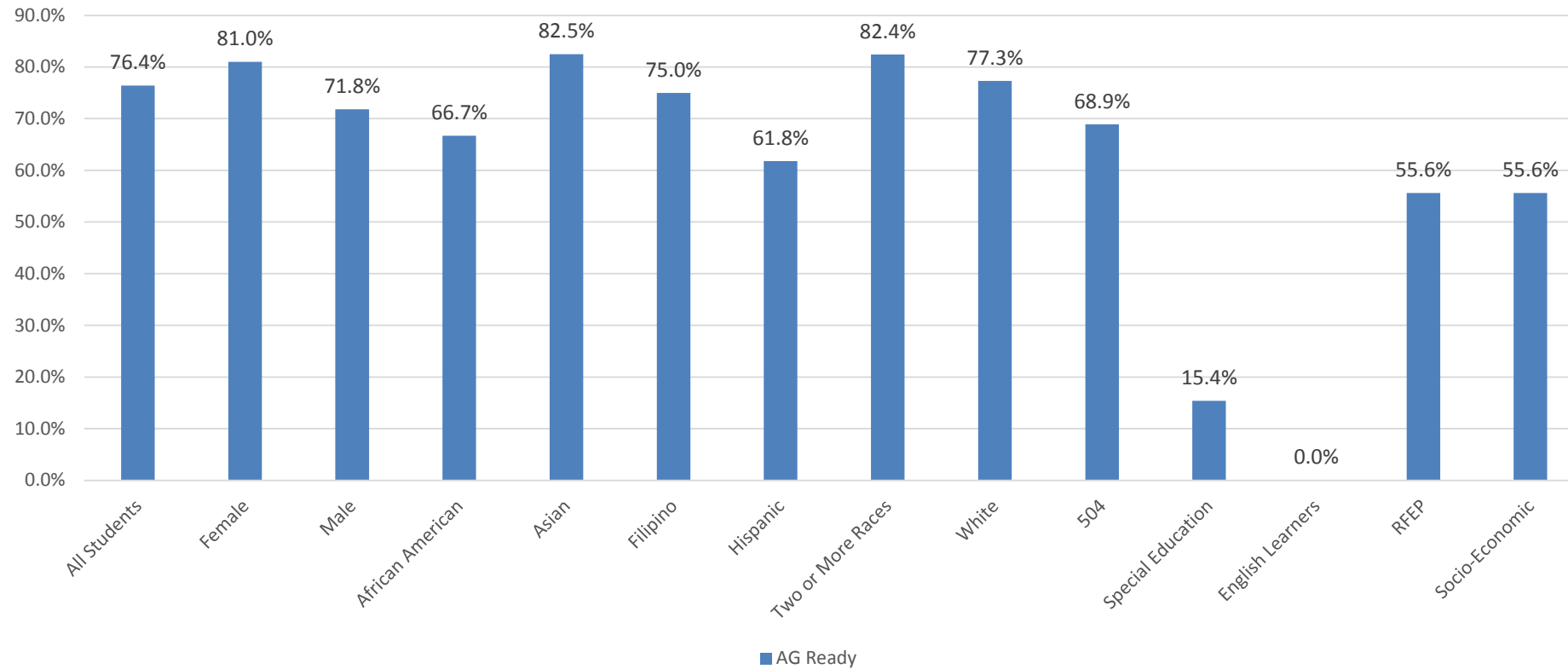
# Graduation Data: A-G Readiness

Percent of Graduates A-G Ready, 2016-2018

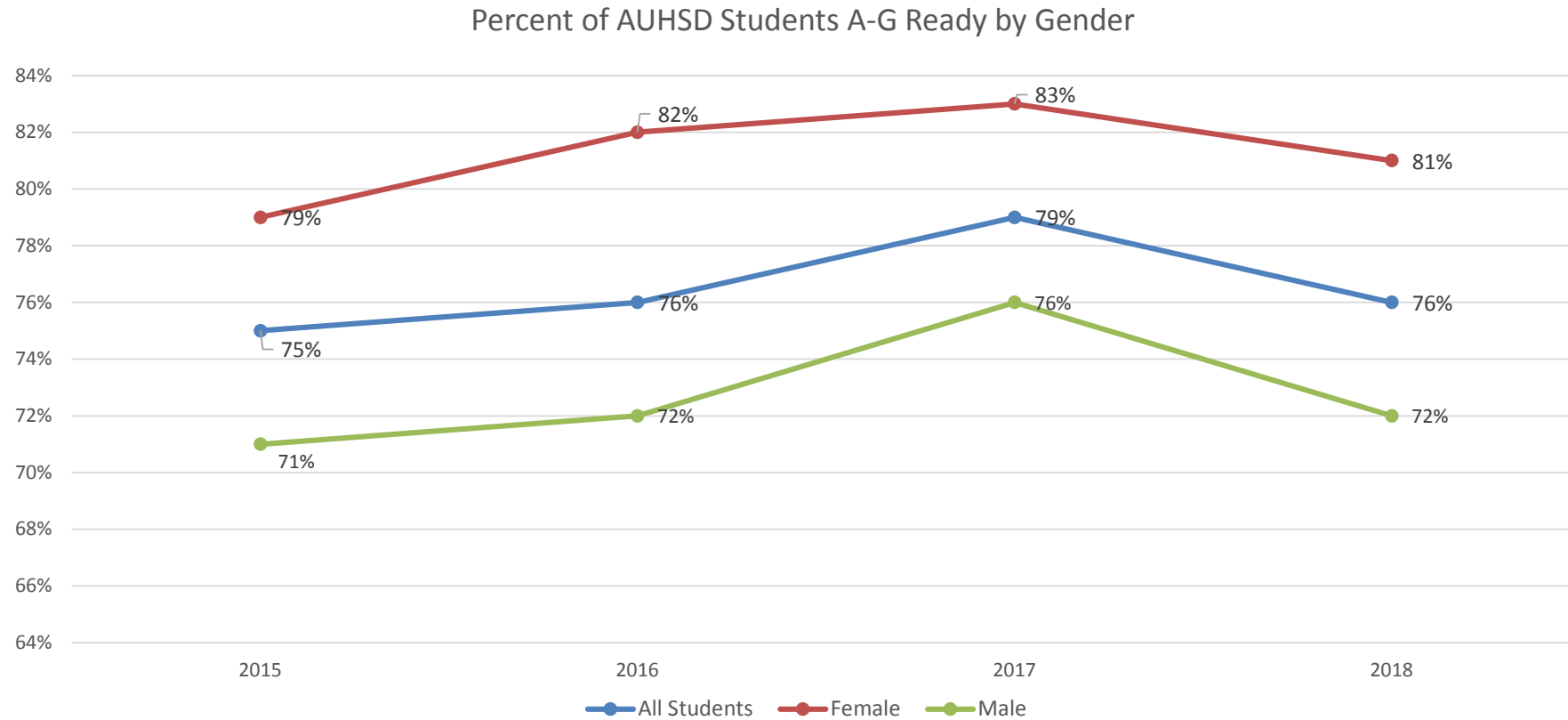


# Graduation Data: A-G Readiness by Subgroup

Percent of AUHSD 2018 Graduates - A-G Ready

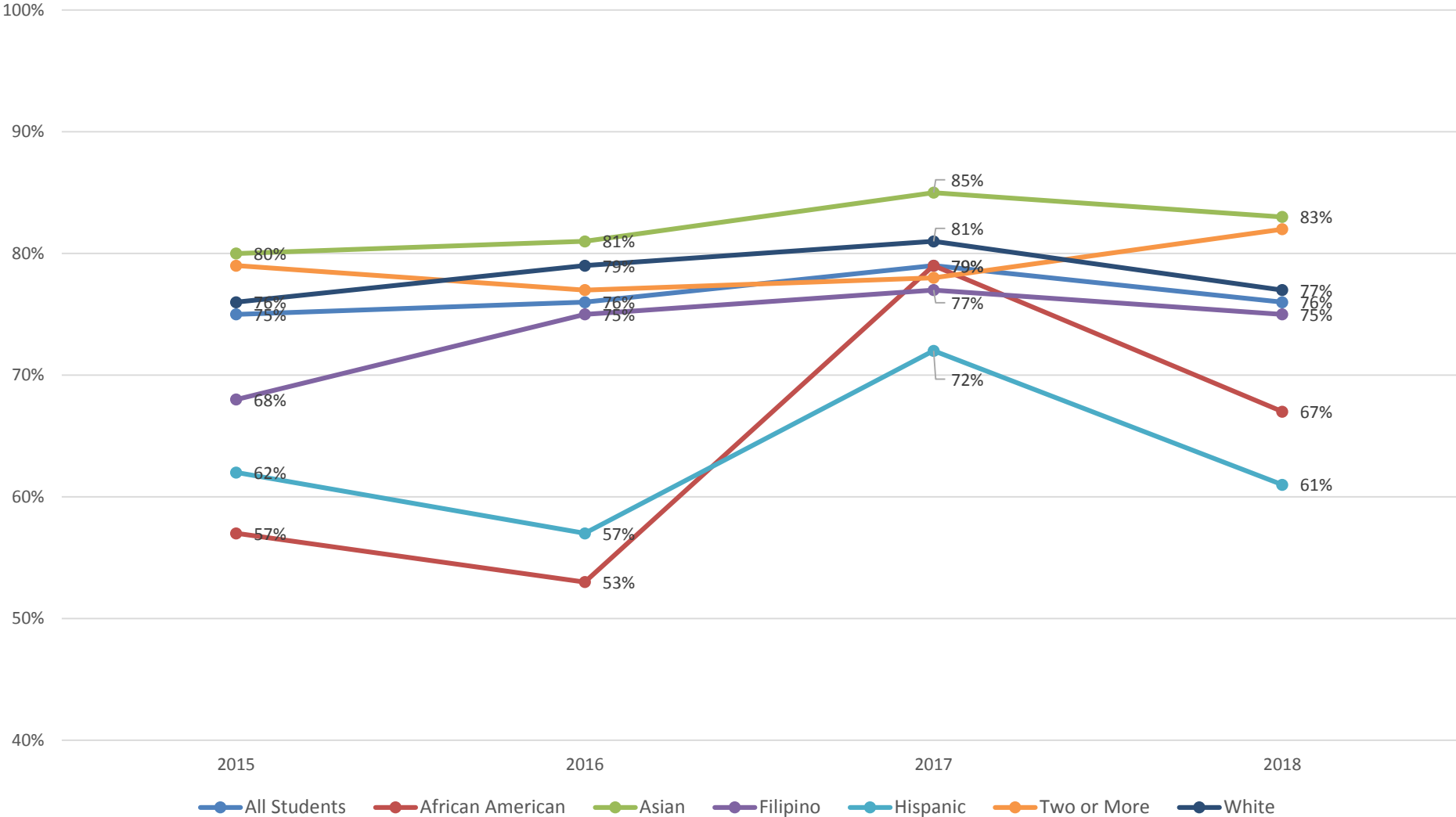


# Graduation Data: A-G Readiness by Subgroup (Gender)

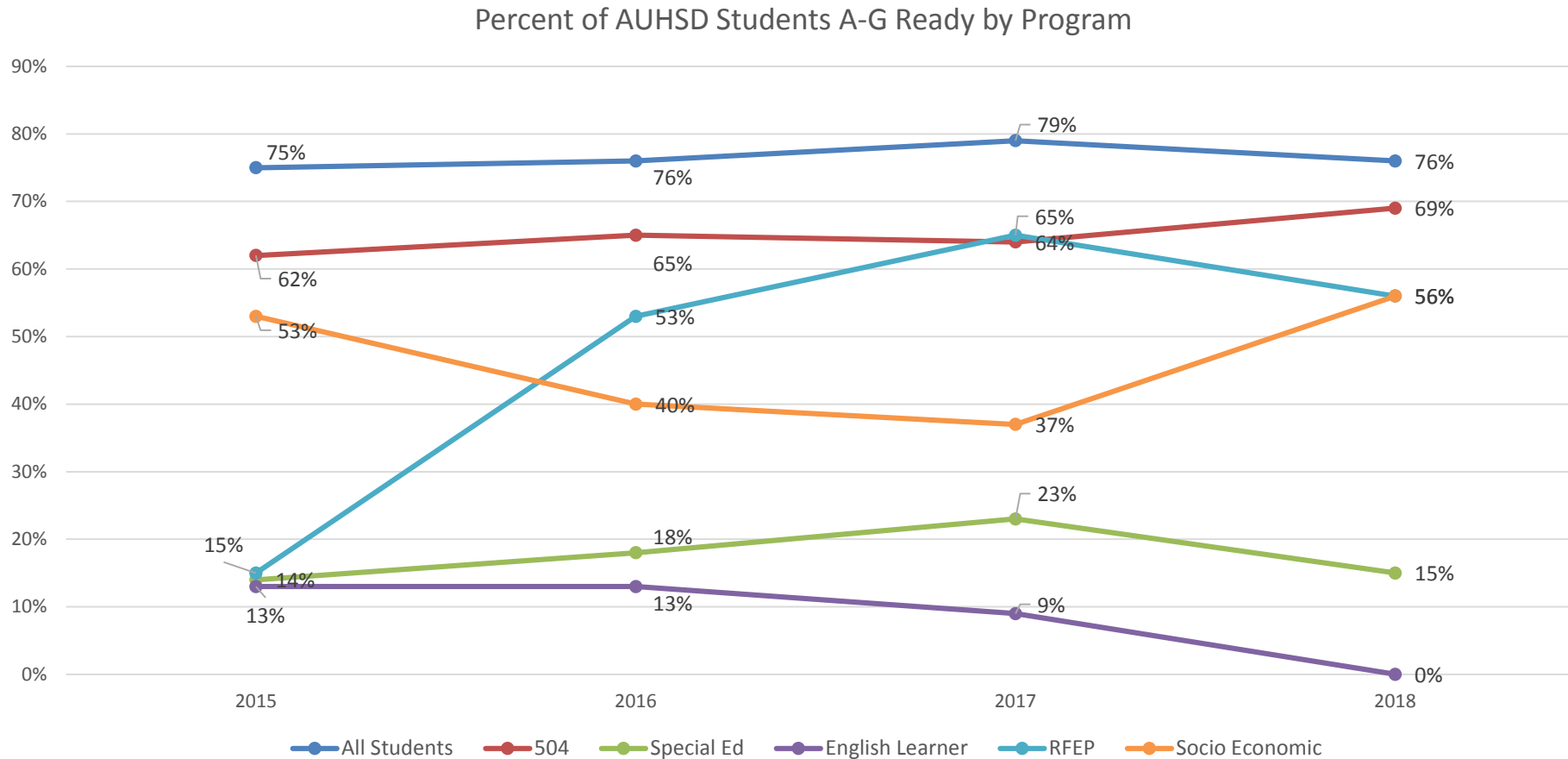


# Graduation Data: AG Readiness by Subgroup (Race and Ethnicity)

Percent of AUHSD Students A-G Ready by Race/Ethnicity

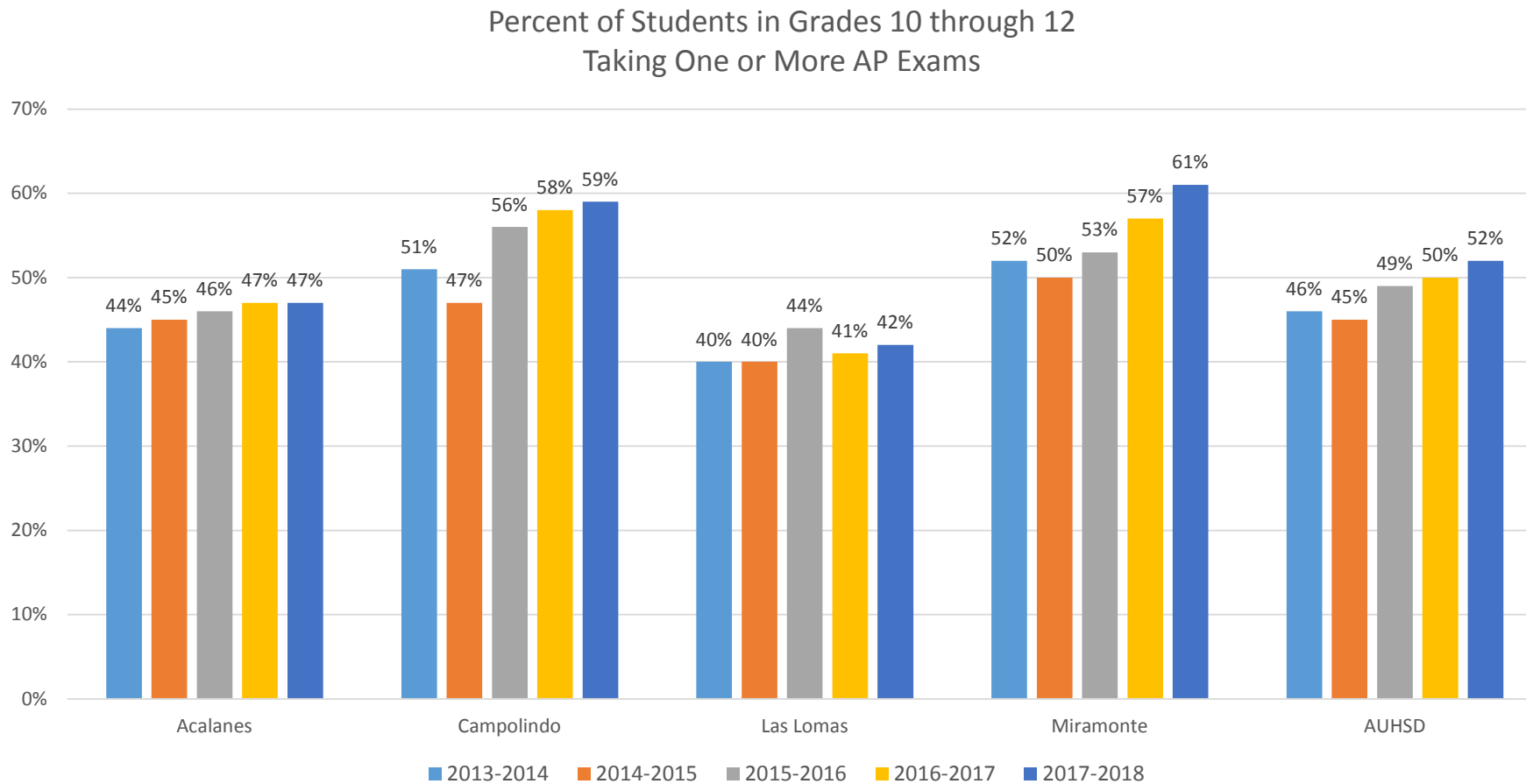


# Graduation Data: AG Readiness by Subgroup (Program)



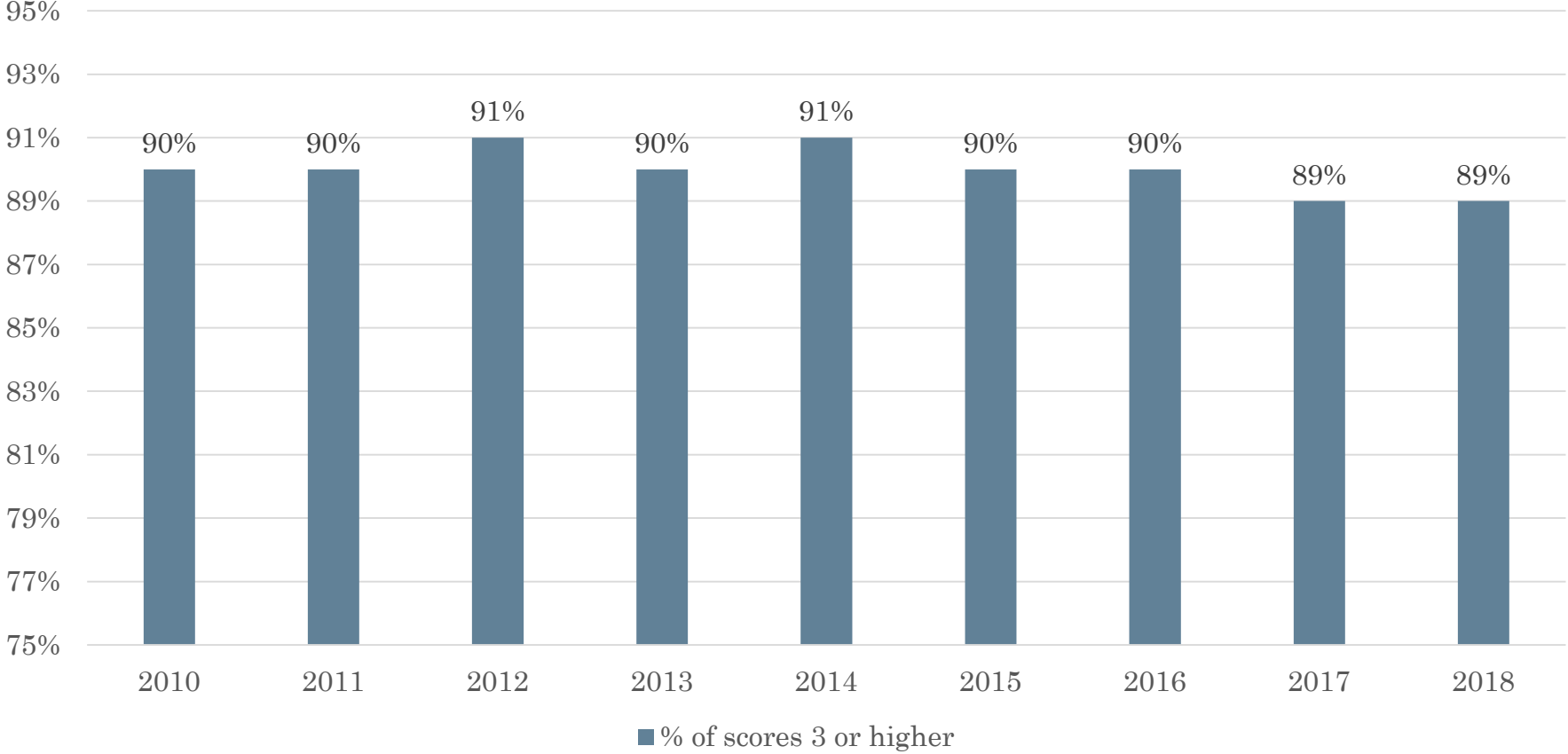
# Advanced Placement Exams

- Percent of students in grades 10 through 12, taking one or more AP exams

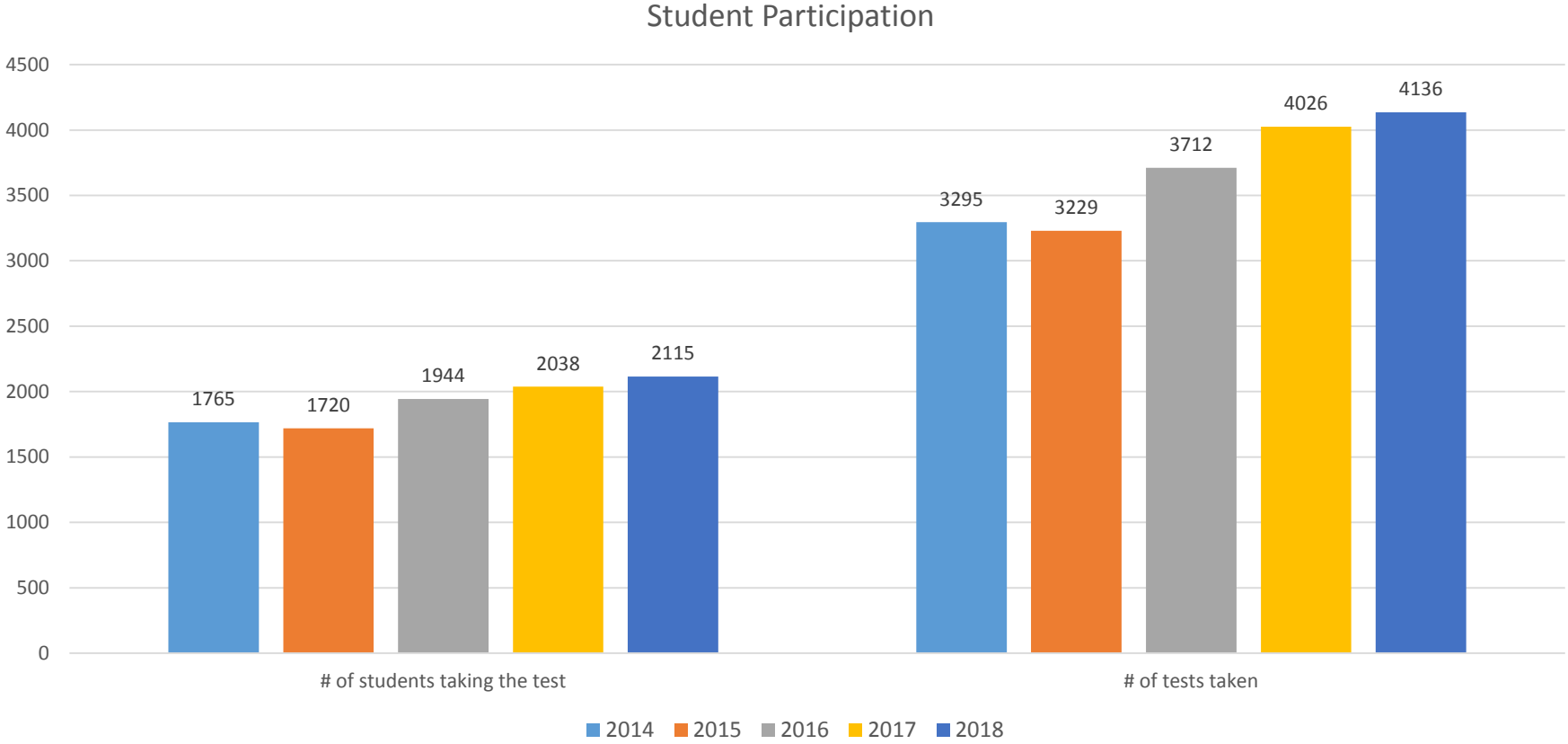


# Advanced Placement Exams

# Advanced Placement Exam

- Observations
  - Percent of students taking the AP courses has increased across the district
  - AP exam passing rate continues to be high (89%)
  - AP courses have been aligned to the new standards and the changing College Board expectations
  - Some increase seen when examining the various student subgroup participation in the AP enrollment and assessment participation (will be part of LCAP data), however participation and achievement gap persists.



# College Entrance Exams - SAT

- SAT Program
  - SAT data based on the new SAT (redesigned SAT)
  - 2018 was the second year of administration of the new SAT
  - First administration of the new SAT was in March 2016
  - Key changes to the SAT include:
    - More accurate alignment to high school curriculum
    - Shift in vocabulary (words in context)
    - Emphasis on use of evidence in answers
    - Optional essay
    - Removal of penalty for incorrect answers
    - Free tutoring through partnership with Khan Academy
- SAT Subject Tests
  - Remain unchanged



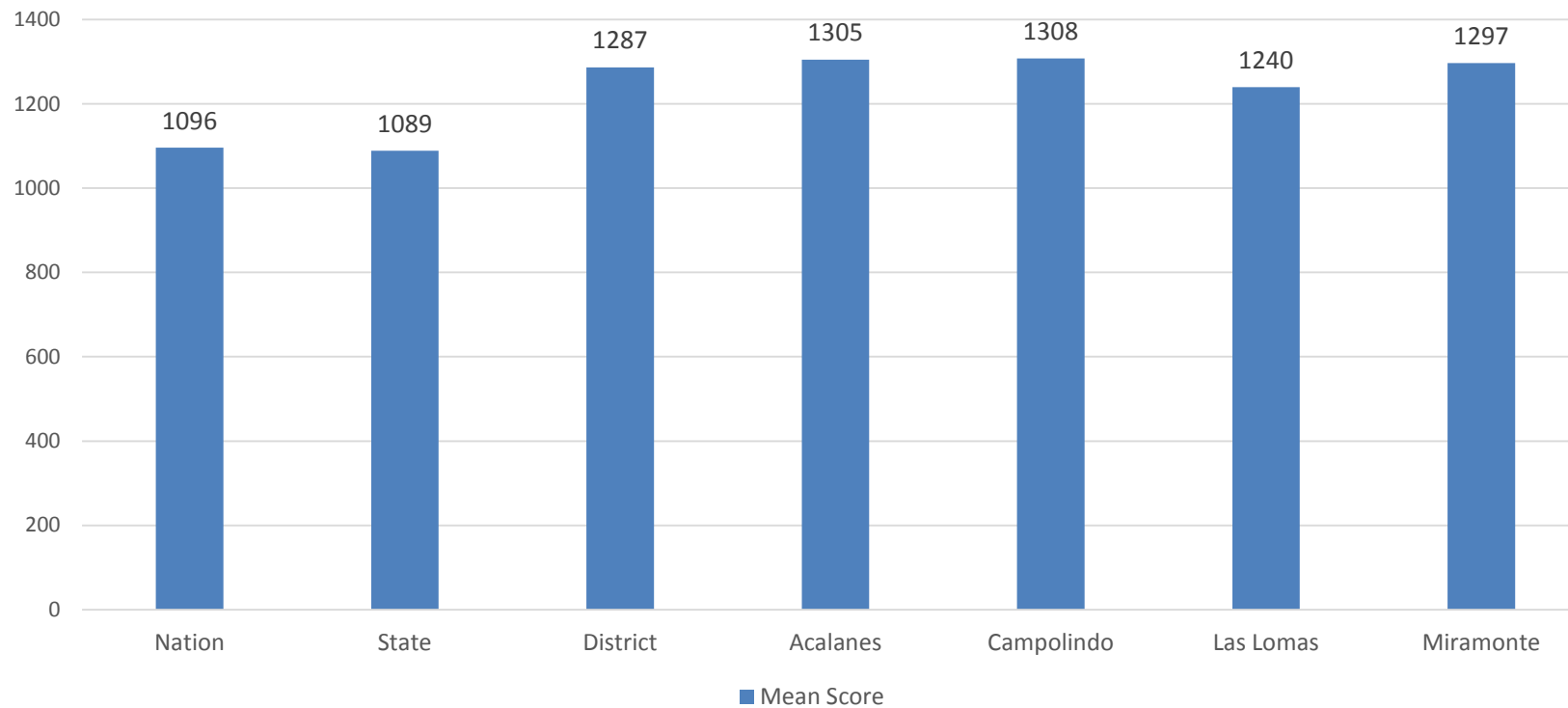

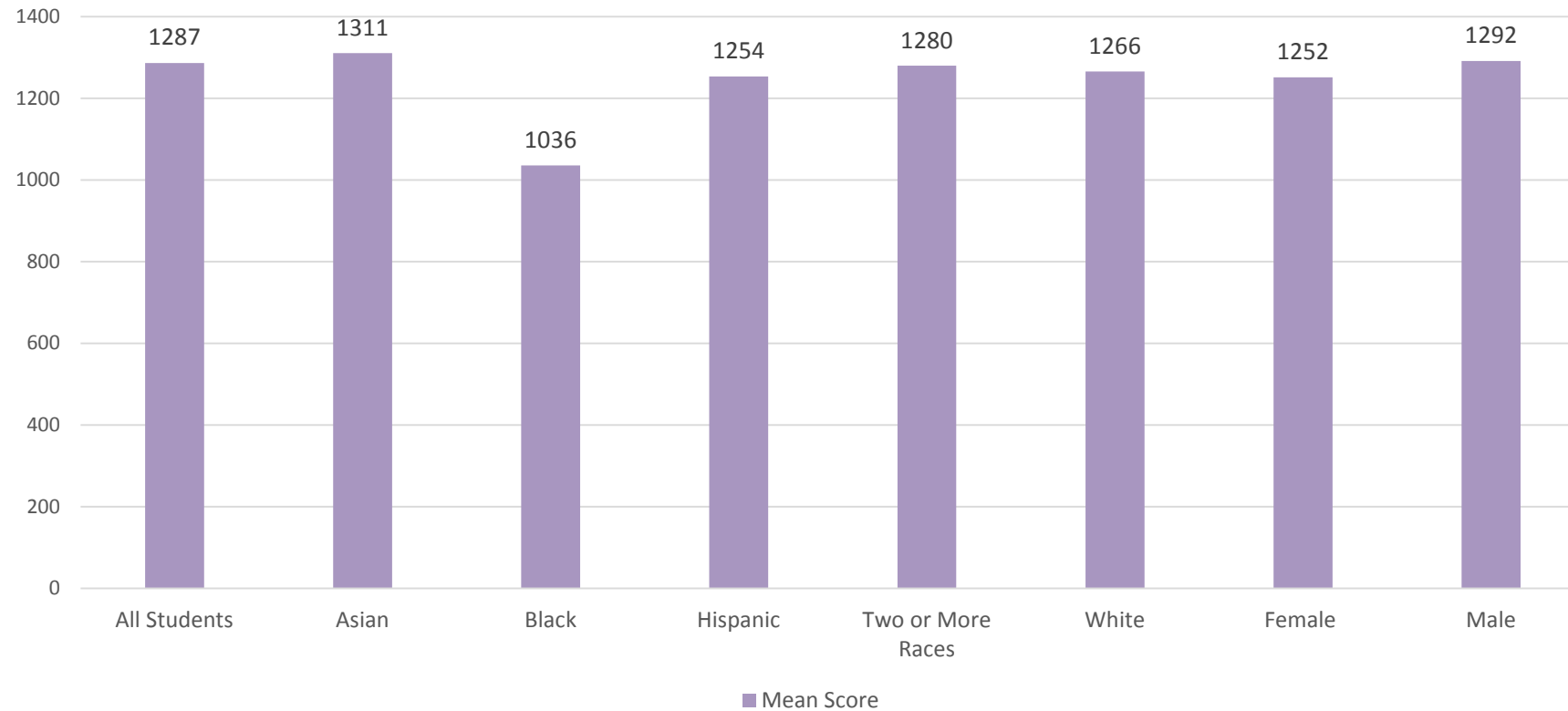

SAT Mean Score – Class of 2018 Student Cohort by Subgroup



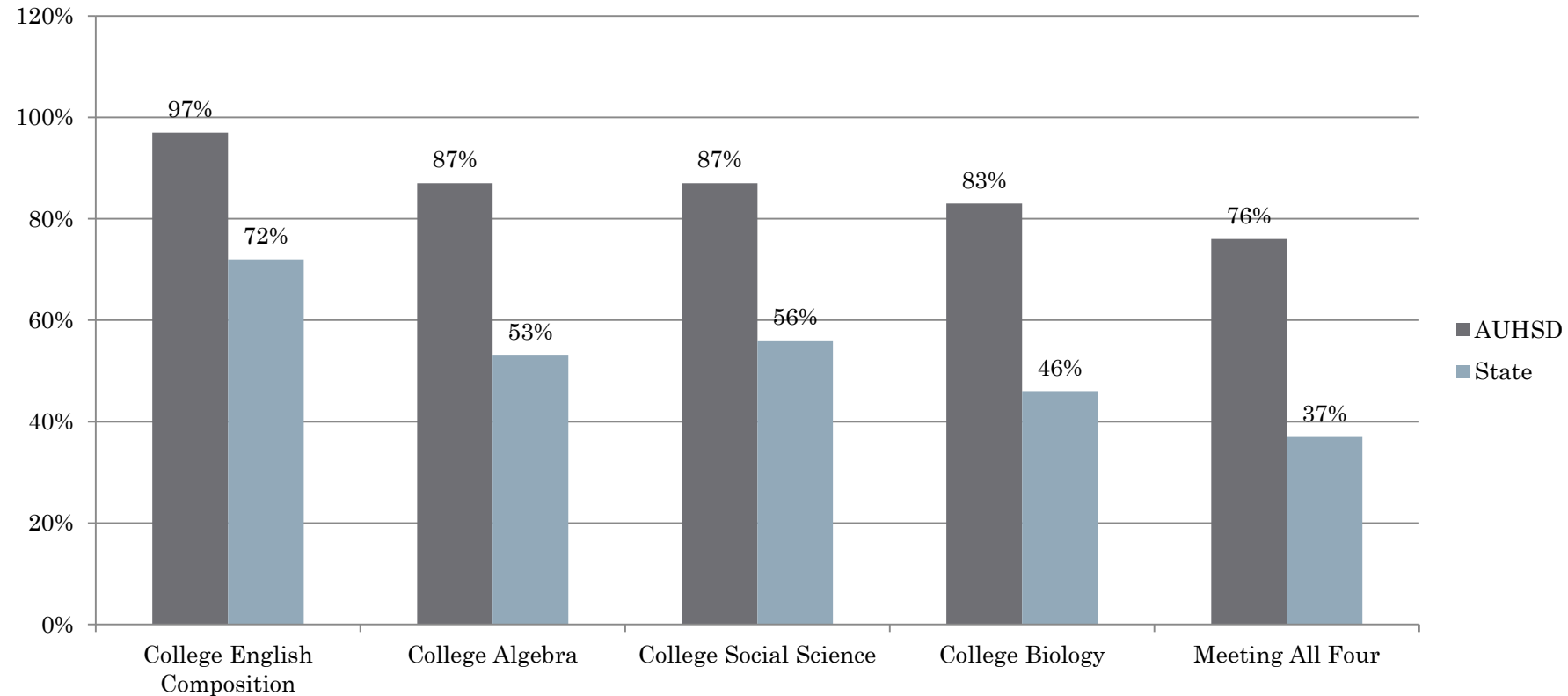
# College Entrance Exams - ACT

  - No major changes in the assessment
  - Continuous adjustment to align the assessment to the standards and curriculum
  - Assessment consists of :
    - Four multiple choice tests:
      - English
      - Math
      - Reading
      - Science
    - Writing component is optional



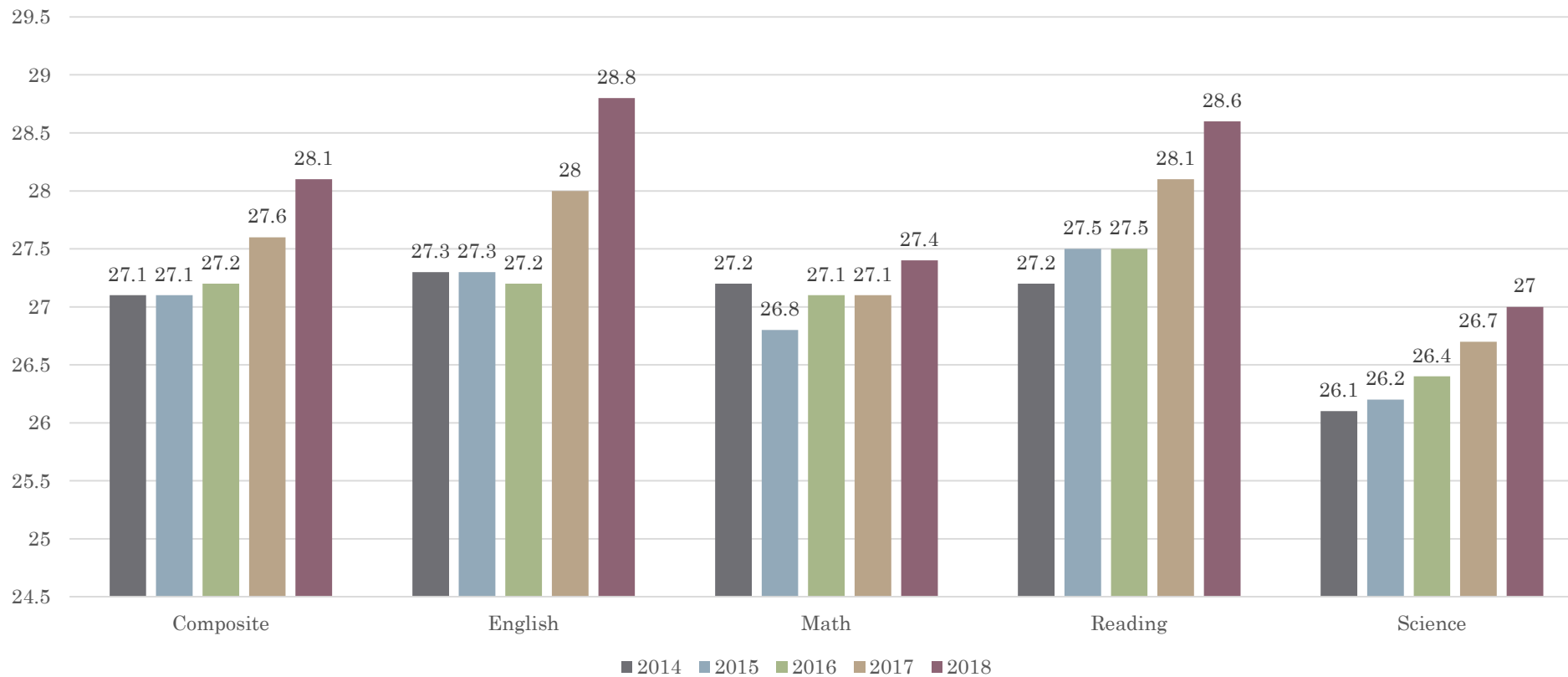
# College Entrance Exams - ACT
