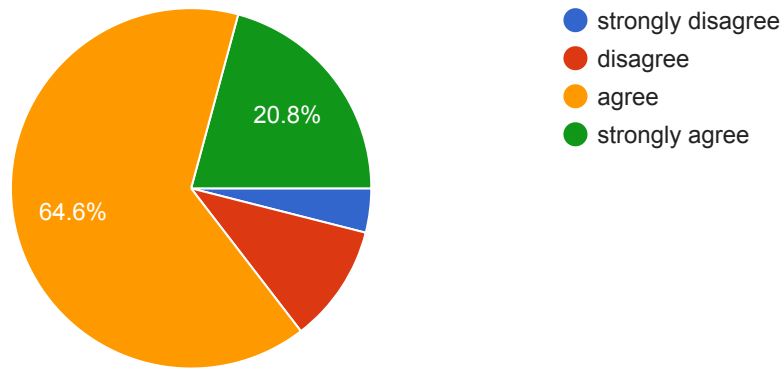

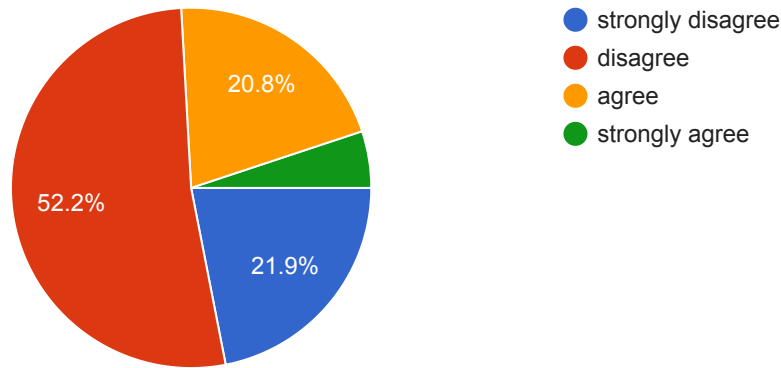

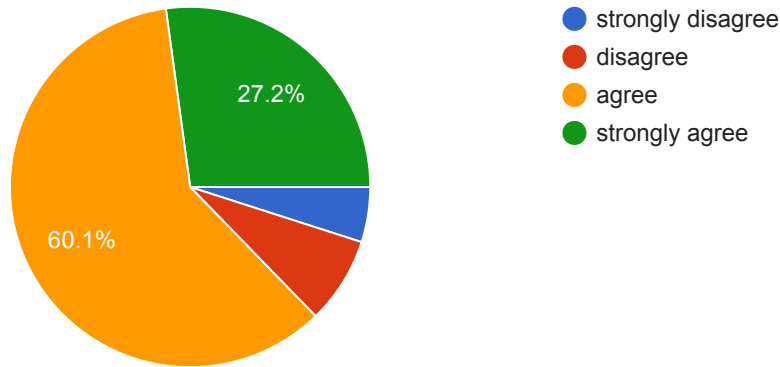

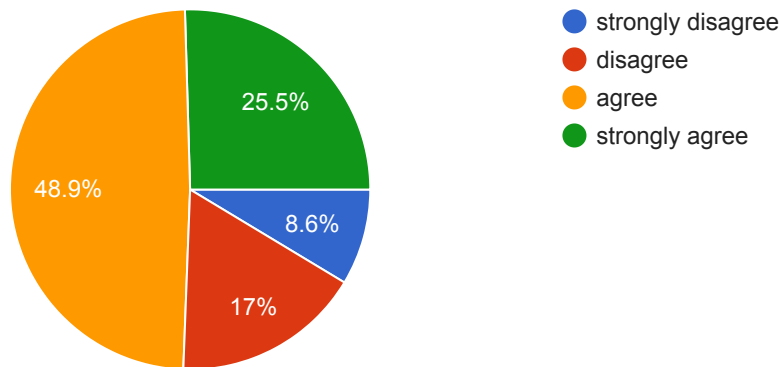

There is at least one teacher or adult I can talk to at Campo if I have a non-academic problem.



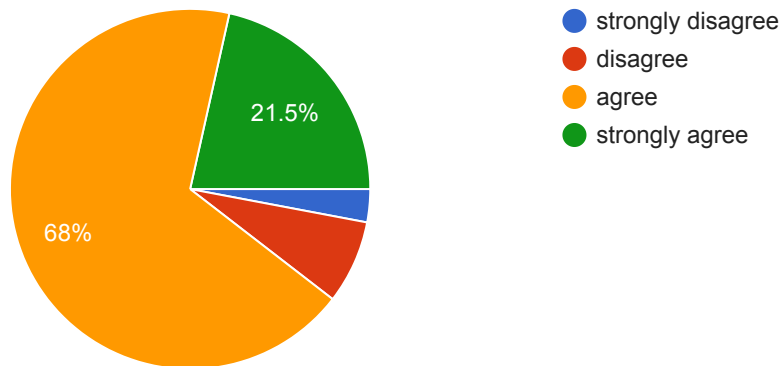

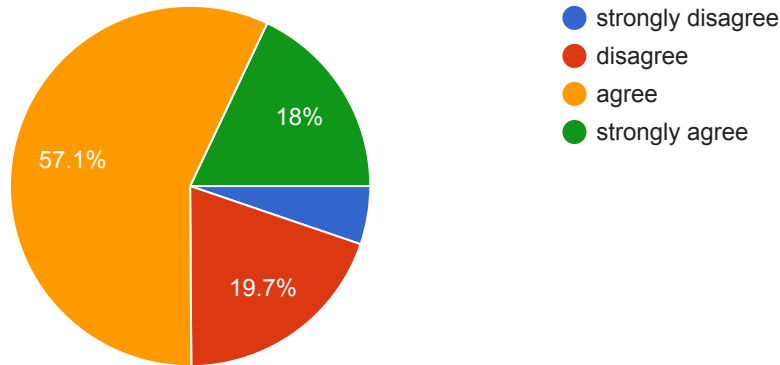

I feel like a valued member of the community. (This means I am seen and recognized by the Campo community regardless of my academic standing and extracurricular involvement.)



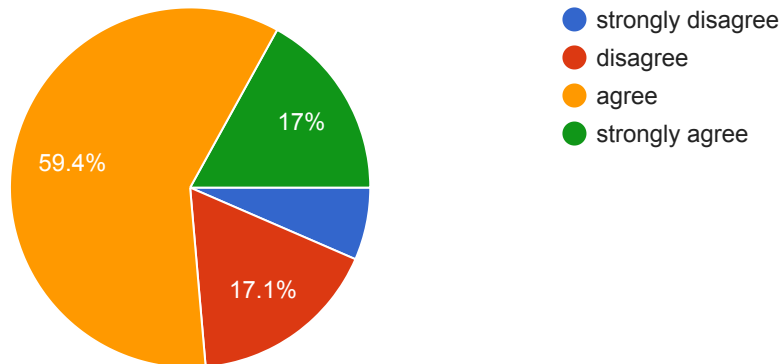

I feel safe when I share or I am open with my identity, beliefs, politics, fashion, religion, culture, background, race, etc..



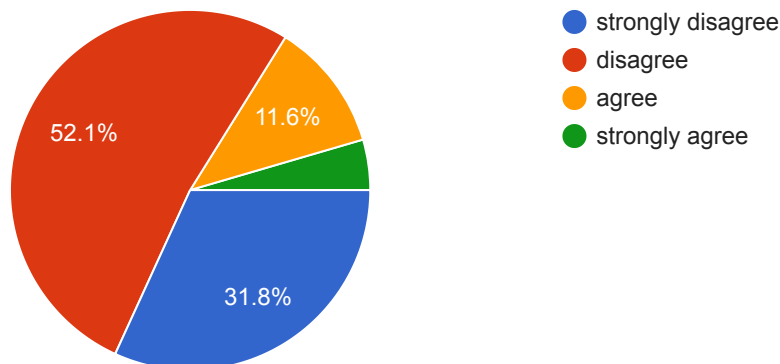

I wish I were at a different school.



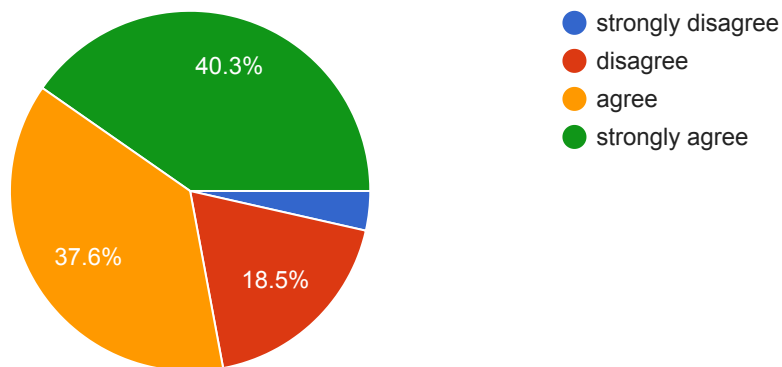

I am often or always stressed by schoolwork.



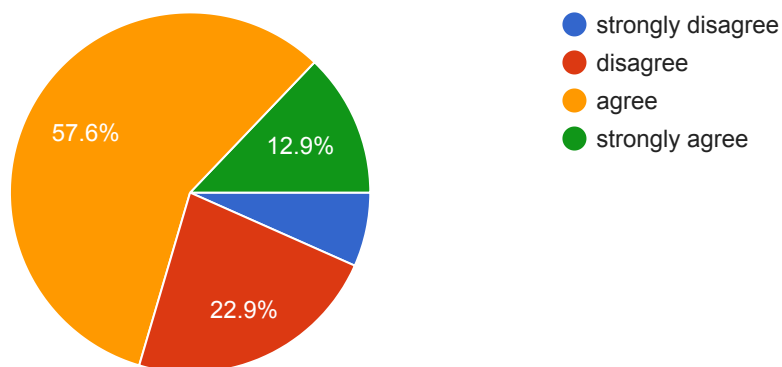

I feel like I can voice my opinions when in class, during discussions, being interviewed by school organizations or publications, and answering questions without being judged.



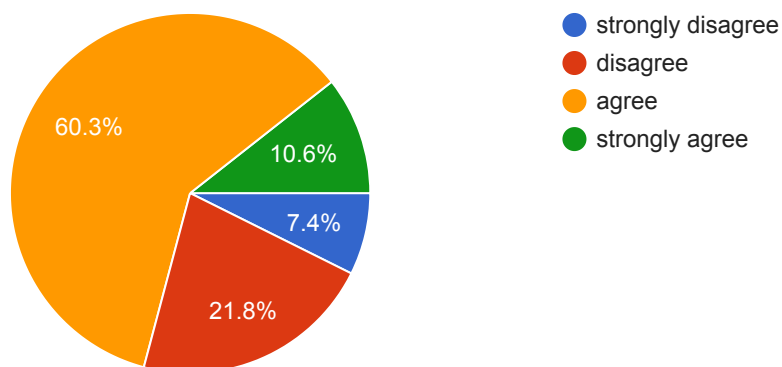

I can see my perspectives reflected in Campo curriculum, events, sports, etc.



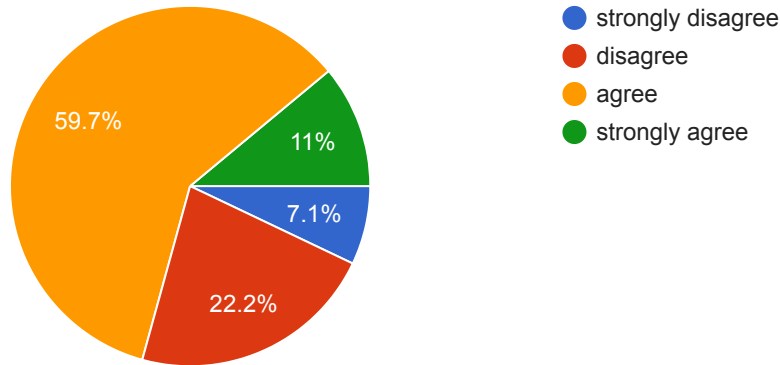

I can see myself reflected in the curriculum, and I feel like personal identities and diverse perspectives are consistently incorporated into the curriculum.



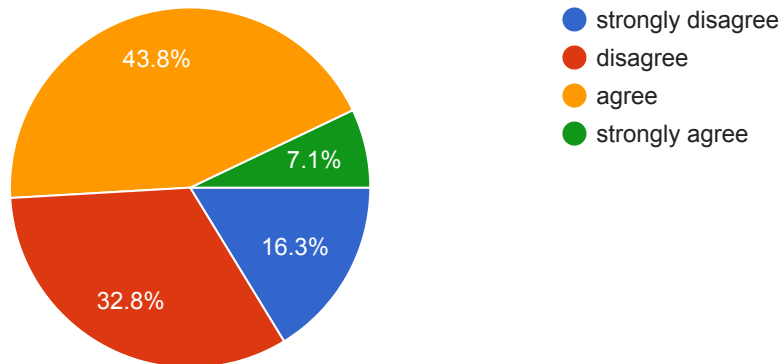
