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States like New York and Alaska average over \$20,000 per pupil, while the Moraga School District and Acalanes Union High School District (Campolindo High School) received roughly \$8,700 and \$10,100, respectively, per pupil in 2015-2016, putting us near the BOTTOM of the state and the country. Without private funding support from our community, our students receive only a fraction of the investment needed to provide them a quality education.

**Homework: New AUHSD Policy**

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## *Administrative Regulation*

- Approximately 2 hours of focused, undistracted homework time per week, including weekends
- Assignments will be designed so that a large majority of students can complete satisfactorily within the expected amount of time.
- AP and Honors courses may have greater workloads.

# **Amount of Homework**

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- Teachers shall **clearly communicate purpose and relevance**.
- Homework assigned **in class** providing time to ask questions.
- **Posted on the District designated online platform** by the end of the school day in which it is assigned. (AR: Posting should be completed no later than 4:00pm of the school day in which it is assigned.)

# Communication - Homework

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- Homework deadlines will be on the day the class meets.
- No weekend deadlines.
- First week of semester: Diagnostic and benchmark assessments only.
- Finals week: Review material or material connected to the final only.

## **Due Dates & Deadlines**

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- For College Prep, Non-College Prep and Honors Classes
  - No homework during the extended school breaks (Summer, Thanksgiving, Winter, Spring)
  - Long-term projects in all courses may span Thanksgiving and Spring breaks and multiple weekends; however, such assignments may not be due immediately following an extended school break.
- For Advanced Placement Courses
  - Teachers of AP courses may assign reasonable homework during Summer and Spring Breaks.
  - Summer homework assigned by AP teachers shall be pre-approved by the Principal.
  - Group work shall not be assigned during extended school breaks (Thanksgiving, Winter, Spring breaks)

# Homework During Breaks

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Assignments must be made up by the student within two course periods of when the assignment was due.
