Acalanes Union High School District Parent and Student Agreement 2020-2021

The Acalanes Union High School District is committed to providing a safe, inclusive, and welcoming environment for all students, staff, and families. As we continue to navigate these unprecedented times together, and transition to in-person learning opportunities at our school sites, we are calling upon the entire community to help us maintain the safety and health of our schools through responsible actions and following public health best practices. For all AUHSD students returning to campus this year for small group instruction they must commit to follow the guidance outlined below.

Before students arrive at AUHSD school sites, they will:

- Perform a self-assessment of COVID-19 symptoms and remain at home if any symptoms listed on the checklist are present) or they have a household member who is positive for COVID-19.
- Bring proof of symptom checking to school and proceed directly to their classroom or instruction area.
- Alert the school site immediately if a student, staff member, or member of the household tests positive for COVID-19 OR has been exposed to someone with COVID-19 symptoms or a confirmed/suspected case.
- Consult with a healthcare provider about testing recommendations if a student has had close contact (closer than 6 feet for more than 15 minutes) with someone who has COVID-19.
- Abide by County and State guidance for physical distancing, mask wearing in public, avoiding large gatherings or gatherings where attendees are not practicing appropriate safety measures, and maintaining appropriate handwashing and hygiene practices.

When students are on AUHSD school sites, they will:

- Proceed directly to their classroom check in area with their completed symptom screen and follow sign in/sign out procedures.
- Sanitize their work area as directed by staff.
- Maintain physical distance of 6 feet between themselves and adults or other students.
- Wear masks that cover the nose and mouth at all times. Bandanas and neck gaiters are not recommended by the CDC and may not be worn in instead of a mask
- Wash or sanitize hands appropriately prior to arrival on campus and frequently throughout the day (before and after eating, using the restroom,

- entering and leaving classrooms, etc.).
- Avoid sharing food, supplies, materials, etc.
- Follow individual school procedures for drop off, pick up, and moving throughout the school campuses.

Please note:

• Parents may not accompany students on campus. If parents wish to speak to a teacher or administrator, they should email or call them.

Students: I understand that the above expectations are established to promote the collective well-being of the AUHSD community. I will follow these practices to support my own health, but also to help safeguard the health and wellbeing of those around me.
